### **Environmental Trust Account**

The El Dorado Gun Club is establishing a trust account: "Environmental Trust" account in the amount of \$10,000. There is an organization out there that is looking to close down gun clubs in California. We have been notified that we are on a list of potential gun clubs that they are looking at. They are looking at lead fragments and dissolved lead that can potentially be transported off the shooting range property and into creeks during erosive rainfall. In an effort to be pro-active, the officers and BOD have retained a lawyer that has been dealing with this sort of investigation. We are working closely with NRA representatives, lawyers and Environmental Specialists to do whatever we need to do to keep our gun club open and free of potential closure.
