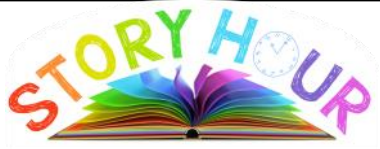

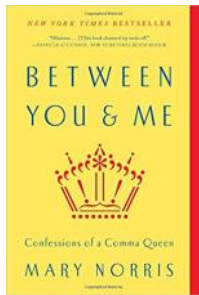

Exhibit runs through August 20th

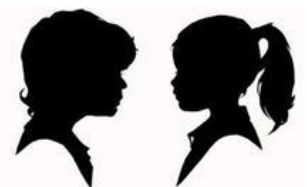
"As the Sparrow Sees" by Joe Martino
