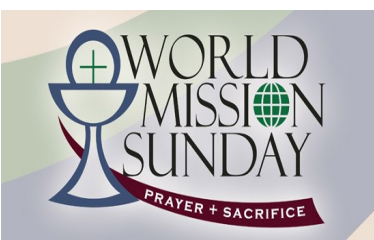
FUNERAL FOR MARILYN SOLOMONSON

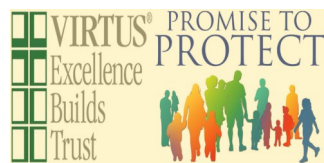

5% COMMITTEE WILL MEET

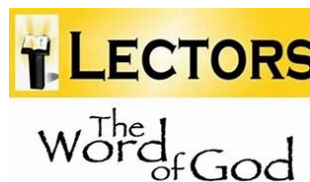
