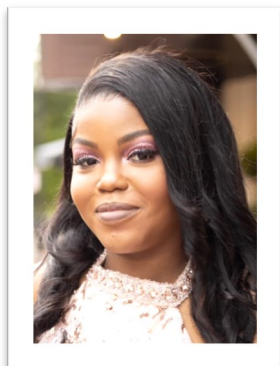

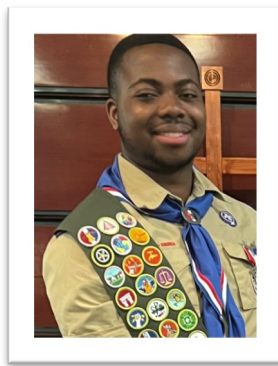

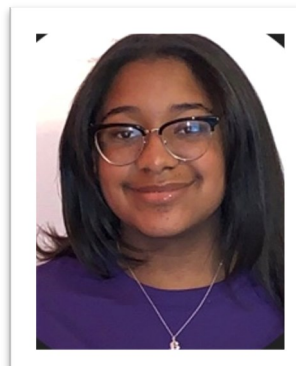

Frequently Asked Questions

The retreat is held at the Sheraton Norfolk Waterside Hotel, 777 Waterside Drive, Norfolk, VA 23510.

Does my church need to send adults leaders: Yes! A church may bring as many adult leaders as they wish. However, we require that churches have a ratio of 1 male leader for every 1-3 male youth and 1 female leader for every 1-3 female youth.

Is there a registration cost: Yes, the early registration cost is \$150.00 per person; this cost includes all meals, all activities, retreat materials for the retreat.

Where is check-in: Check-in will be near the hotel lobby front desk.

What about the accommodations: Each church must make their own reservations with the Hotel.

The Sheraton Norfolk Waterside Hotel is located at 777 Waterside Drive, Norfolk, Virginia 23510; and the phone number is (757) 622-6664. The hotel provides double room (2 queen-size beds) accommodation at \$145.00 per room night (plus taxes and fees). There must be at least 1 adult (age 25 and above) staying in each room with the children and youth registrants unless there is a connecting room. In this situation, the adult can stay in the connecting room. For larger groups, sleeping bags are encouraged. There is NO CO-ED visitation permitted during the retreat. What should I wear during the Annual Session: Dress is casual (no revealing clothing) for the session. Bring comfortable clothing and shoes.

Do adult leaders have to fill out the medical waiver also: Yes, all persons (children, youth & adults) in order to attend the retreat must completely fill out the medical waiver. The medical waiver should be turned in along with the retreat registration.

What do churches do about children and youth taking medication: Adult leaders should be aware of any medical condition that may affect their students. Children and youth should carry and administer their medication at all times. In case of emergency a medical professional will be contacted.

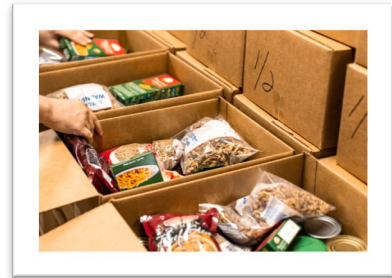

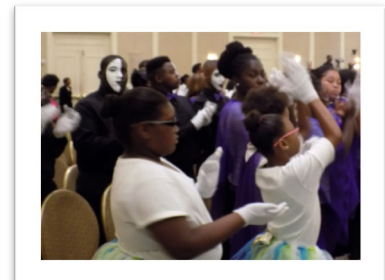
