

#### From the West

Take PA Turnpike to Exit 57 (Monroeville.) After tollbooth take far right exit ramp toward Murrysville. Follow Route 22 East through Murrysville to intersection with Route 66 (10.4 miles.) Take Route 66 North ramp to Delmont.

#### \*\*\*From the intersection of Rt. 22 and Rt. 66:

Continue north on Route 66 (2.9 miles) through two traffic lights, past Delmont Auto Sales on the right and Valero Century RV Sales on the left. Just after you pass the Delmont Veterinary Hospital on the left, turn RIGHT into driveway for the Delmont North Industrial Park. Continue to the buildings at the top of the hill.

#### From the South or East

Entries without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after trial closes. If a <u>legible</u> email address is provided, judging program and confirmation of entry <u>will be emailed</u>. Paper copies will only be mailed by request. Should acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary at 412-310-5564.

The two Rally trials will be held in two rings/buildings. Trial 1 will start at 8:00 AM; Trial 2 will start at 9:30 AM. Classes in trial 2 will be arranged to minimize conflicts.

**Transfer/Move-up Policy: Rally transfers** to another class will be accepted as space permits within entry limits, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Rally Regulations. Requests for transfer must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary <u>at least 30 minutes</u> <u>before the start of trial.</u> Forms may be downloaded from the AKC website at <u>www.akc.org</u> or requested from the Trial Secretary.

**Post-Dated Checks and Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. WCOTC will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries**. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

**Declination of Entries**. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog because of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against WCOTC or any official thereof.

**Entry Fees Shall Not be Refunded** in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in the filling out of entry forms. Corrections cannot be made after the closing date. Please be certain that you fill in the right class and have the correct jump height on your entries. No entry and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors, or for cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or <u>print carefully</u> on entry forms to eliminate errors.

**Bitches in Season** will not be admitted to the Trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season on the Trial date will be refunded the entry fee less \$5.00 (each trial) upon written certification by a veterinarian given to the Trial Secretary before the start of judging of each trial.

#### Exhibitors are Responsible for the Behavior of Their Dogs and/or Children.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

**Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.** Every effort will be made to assure everyone gets to have all of their scheduled runs. If you will have a ring conflict, please let the judge/stewards know when you check in. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when they are called to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.
