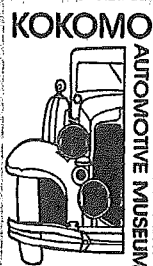
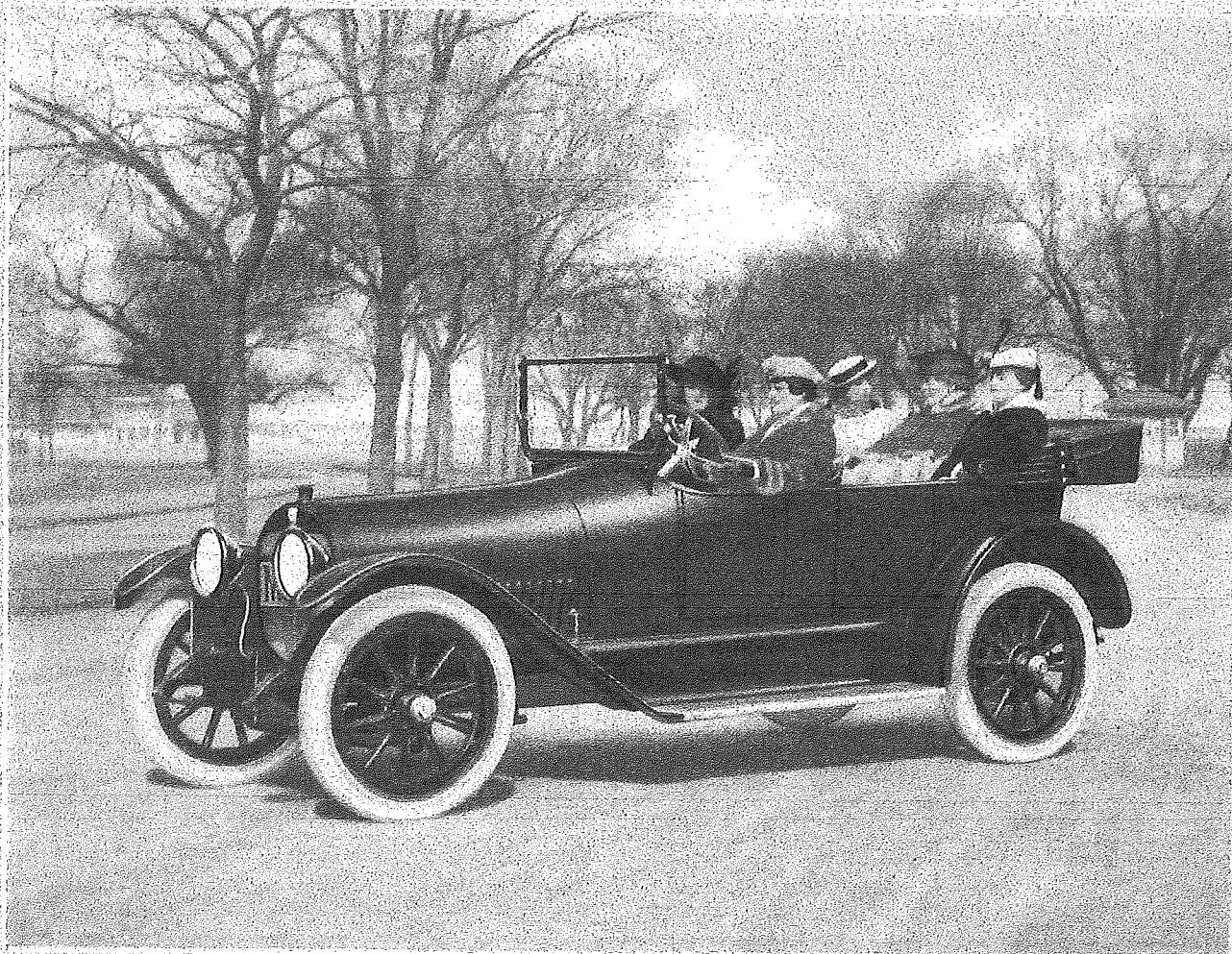

"Hoosier Heritage Bicentennial Driving Tour" Fees

Registration fee (\$50 per vehicle)

The registration fee covers the entry of one vehicle, the driver, one adult passenger and up to two minor children. Included are one set of driving directions, one 2016 Indiana highway map, one dash plaque, one commemorative license plate, one lanyard and ID badge per person, and an invitation for the driver, 2nd adult, and up to two minor children to the Driver's Breakfast at the Kokomo Automotive Museum on Monday, September 5 prior to the tour departure. A late fee of \$15 will be assessed after August 1, 2016.

Guests (\$20 per adult guest, not counting driver and 1st adult)

For a nominal fee, additional adults can ride along. They will also have to register for the daily events along with the driver.

Daily Fees (\$50 to \$92 per person, per day)

Daily Fees include all activities for that day, as well as lunch and supper, unless otherwise noted.
