Contact Team Update

First, what is the "Contact Team?"

The Contact Team is a group of neighbors who act as advocates for our neighborhood plan. They work with city staff towards implementation of plans, help create amendments, serve as community points of contact, and work on behalf of other neighborhood stakeholders.

In short, we help to keep an open line of communication with the City regarding our neighborhood.

Currently, we are using 10-15 minutes of the Neighborhood Association monthly meeting for Contact Team updates and input.

This month we attended the city-wide Code Next draft release. Code Next is Austin's first major overhaul of city code since the '80s, and it will affect what can be built and where. **That means it affects our neighborhood and you!** Come to the CHNA meeting this month to learn more!

Front Yard Parking

To help keep our neighborhood inviting and attractive, each month we will highlight some City laws that apply to us here in Coronado Hills/Creekside.

This month we focus on parking cars on our lawns. City law *prohibits a person from parking a motor vehicle in the front or side yard of a residential property* except in a driveway or a paved parking space. This has been the case here in our neighborhood since 2002. Violators can be fined and their vehicles towed.
