#### Philippians 4:19

#### Principles to live by when you'r looking for God to provide financially

**Philippians 4:19** — "And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus."

#### I. Ask God to provide.

Matthew 7:7–8 — "7 "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened."

- A. Ask, Search, Knock -- what does that spell? ASK.
- B. Before you pay for it, pray for it. -John 16:24

#### II. Learn to be content.

**1 Timothy 6:6-7,** NIV - "But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it."

# A. Contentment means my happiness is not dependent upon circumstances.

1. It depends on the fact that God has provided for my needs.

#### III. Practice giving in faith.

- A. We must practice the principle of sowing and reaping.
  - 1. We will reap what we sow.
  - 2. **Example:** Every farmer knows this principle.
  - **3. Lesson:** When you have a need, plant a seed.
- B. Faith is required for Sowing and giving. Hebrews 11:6

**Hebrews 11:6** — "<sup>6</sup> And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him."

1. It seems illogical that when I have a need, I should give.

That's why it requires faith.

- 3. Why did God set it up that way? Because God is a giver. *Proverbs 3:9–10*

## IV. Be honest with your financial dealing.

A. God doesn't bless dishonesty.

**Proverbs 16:11** — "A just balance and scales are the Lord's; all the weights in the bag are his work."

- B. If we want God's blessing on your finances, we've got to be honest.
- V. Trust the Lord with your whole life.

**Proverbs 3:5–6** — "<sup>5</sup> Trust in the Lord with all your heart And do not lean on your own understanding. <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He will make your paths straight."
