
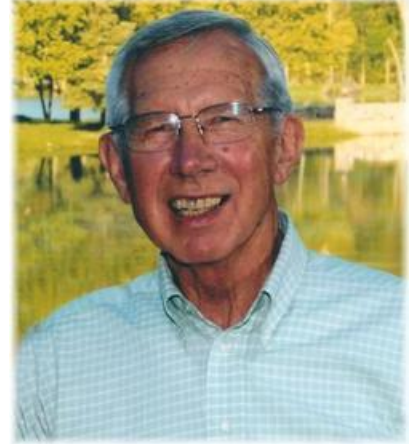


Howard K. Holland
