Dear Parents and Staff,

We have received notification that Nassau County Executive, Laura Curran, has mandated a two-week closure for all school districts for K-12 programs. We are awaiting guidance from NYS Education Department and Nassau County Department of Health, if this applies to Special Education Preschool programs as well.

In accordance with the Connect Ed sent on 3/15, school will be closed for ALL children on Monday, March 16 for a Staff Development Day.

As per the guidance from Laura Curran on MARCH 15, 2020 at 10:40 a.m.:

“Officials in Nassau County announced all K-12 public and private schools will be closed starting Monday for the next two weeks.

Nassau County Executive Laura Curran said the closures are part of the county's containment strategy.

School buildings can still be used by teachers for distance-based learning.”

As such, teachers, therapists, Admin Staff and Admin Support Staff should report at their regularly scheduled time to prepare for the possibility of an extended closure.

In accordance with this directive, ALL SCHOOL - AGE classes will be closed for the mandatory 2 weeks. A decision on the closure of preschool classes (after 3/16) will be forthcoming.

We wanted to provide you with this news as quickly as possible to allow you time to prepare. We know that this closure will be a hardship for many of our children and families.

Additional information regarding the continuity of instruction and potential school closures will be provided, as soon as we receive further guidance from government officials.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate these uncertain times as a community.

Estimados padres y personal,

Hemos recibido una notificación de que la ejecutiva del condado de Nassau, Laura Curran, ha ordenado un cierre de dos semanas para todos los distritos escolares para los programas K-12. Estamos esperando la orientación del Departamento de Educación del Estado de Nueva York y el Departamento de Salud del Condado de Nassau, si esto también se aplica a los programas de Educación Preescolar Especial.

De acuerdo con el Connect Ed enviado el 3/15, la escuela estará cerrada para TODOS los niños el lunes 16 de marzo por un Día de Desarrollo del Personal.

Según la orientación de Laura Curran el 15 de marzo de 2020 a las 10:40 a.m. :

“Funcionarios en el condado de Nassau anunciaron que todas las escuelas públicas y privadas K-12 estarán cerradas a partir del lunes durante las próximas dos semanas.

La ejecutiva del condado de Nassau, Laura Curran, dijo que los cierres son parte de la estrategia de contención del condado.

Los maestros aún pueden usar los edificios escolares para el aprendizaje a distancia ”.

Como tal, los maestros, terapeutas, el personal administrativo y el personal de apoyo administrativo deben informar a su hora programada regularmente para prepararse para la posibilidad de un cierre prolongado.

De acuerdo con esta directiva, TODAS LAS ESCUELAS - EDAD estarán cerradas por las 2 semanas obligatorias. Se tomará una decisión sobre el cierre de las clases de preescolar (después del 3/16).

Queríamos brindarle esta noticia lo más rápido posible para permitirle tiempo para prepararse. Sabemos que este cierre será una dificultad para muchos de nuestros niños y familias.
