ORDINANCE No. 1 1954

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE LIMIT OF PARKING OF VEHICLES
IN THE BUSINESS DISTRICT AND SETTING UP OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE
TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA, INC.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE,
IN THE STATE OF INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 (a) It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle in the
business district of the Town of Cloverdale for a
period of over two (2) hours, between the hours of
7:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., except on Sundays or Holidays.

(b) It shall be unlawful to disobey any traffic signal.

(c) It shall be unlawful to fail to display Vehicle Registration
Certificate, Vehicle License & required Vehicle Lights.

(d) It shall be unlawful to drive through or park any Vehicle
in a safety Zone.

(e) It shall be unlawful to fail to stop a Vehicle at a
preferential street.

(f) It shall be unlawful to park a Vehicle in an alley.

(g) It shall be unlawful to leave a Vehicle with the motor
running.

(h) It shall be unlawful to operate a Vehicle with an open
muffler.

(i) It shall be unlawful to park in front of any fire hydrant,
a vehicle

(j) It shall be unlawful to drive a truck without a mirror.

(k) It shall be unlawful to drive or park a Vehicle improperly.

(l) It shall be unlawful to drive or park a Vehicle on the
left side of any street.

(m) It shall be unlawful to park a vehicle in front of the
entrance to any Hotel, Church, Theatre, School or Public
Building.

(n) It shall be unlawful to park a Vehicle in a Taxi or
Bus stand.

(o) It shall be unlawful to use bright lights on Vehicles.

(p) It shall be unlawful to double park Vehicles on any street.

Section 2 All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith
are hereby repealed.

Section 3 Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions
of this ordinance shall be fined in any sum not less than
ONE Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

Section 4 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its
passage and legal advertisement.
