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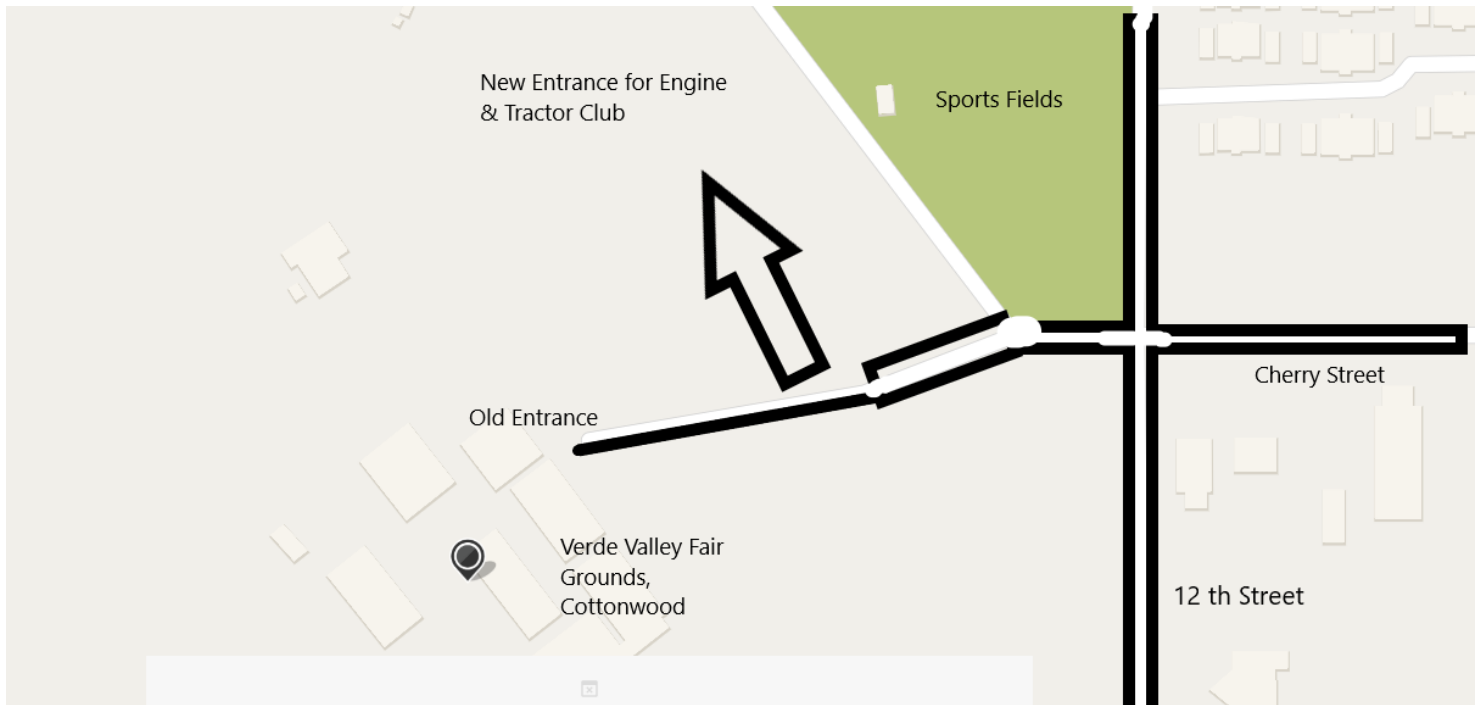

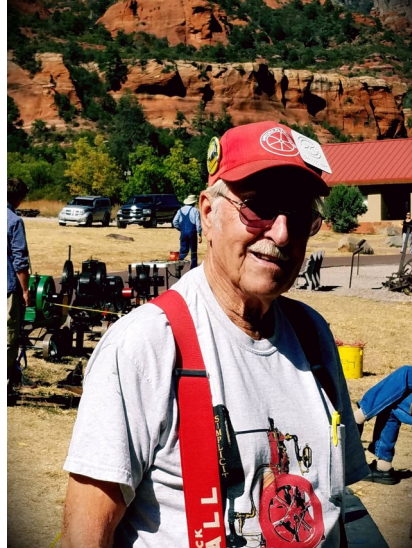

Plugoscillator, A What ?

The plugoscillators are low-tension magneto powered ignitor systems. It produces the ignition spark Inside the cylinder.

And like a Webster system, the movable ignitor shaft should move freely and have a kind of weak spring that holds the internal contacts closed.

The magneto should be free enough to swivel through two or more mechanical oscillations after being tripped.

There should be an adjustment that allows you to set a small gap between the mag hammer and the ignitor shaft (about 0.015") when the magneto is at rest.

When the magneto trips, it pops the points open at the maximum current point, producing the ignition spark.

If the mica insulator washers are in good condition, it should work fine.

Or is this a plug - Oscillator ?
