Hickman County E911 is working on addresses in an effort to help our communities if there is a need for Emergency Services. We understand that this may cause some inconvenience. These corrections are needed so response is as precise and accurate as possible. In order to do this some addresses need to be changed. We HOPE here at 911 you never have a need for the use of 1st Responders, but we have to make an effort to eliminate problems that may hinder response.

As with the case of road signs, the numbering of house/buildings will be of little use unless these structures display the number. Here is a sample check list which may be used:

House Numbers

- 1. House numbers, large enough to be seen from the road. If you can't read them, we can't read them.
- 2. House numbers are set on a background of contrasting color.
- 3. When a house is some distance from the road, or when the view of the house is blocked by trees or shrubs, the numbers should be on a sign attached to a fence, gate, or post close to the road.
- 4. In rural areas, the house number should be seen from the mailbox.
- 5. On a corner lot, the number should face the street named in the address.
- 6. Numbers should be reflected or illuminated.
- 7. Numbers should be in plain block numbers no less than four (4) inches in height.
