

We wish to bring to your attention a newsworthy development that showcases our ongoing successful community/government partnership. As we wait for Sacramento County's development plans for Mather South to proceed, the Mather Alliance formed a task force with some Mather Homeowners Board members, Mather residents, and Sacramento County Regional Parks Rangers.

As you may know, our preserve signage is weathered and dated. Vehicles can easily access our preserve at unblocked areas. Vehicles are extremely threatening and can quickly destroy the sensitive habitat that we so tenaciously try to protect.

Our task force developed a proposal to bolster of Sacramento County Park Rangers' efforts to protect the natural resources and wildlife. Sacramento County Regional Parks approved the task force's proposal to install strategically-placed signage and vehicle access control points. Crews already began installation, which includes 11 pipe gates and 410 boulders. The gates and boulders will not impede pedestrian access.
