- If we saw 7-8/day it would be good this is not the gym at Philippus
- Numbers at OTR may not have been accurate as there were clients that had not been seen in some time
- Closed out a lot of clients and they could always be reopened if they return

#### Sarah continued:

- Met with Nehemiah Manufacturing Company personnel to develop an employment partnership - they have hired one Tamar's participant
- Supplies have remained stocked have not had an issue with lack of supplies

Sr. Ann: Are there many transgendered participants?

Pamela: As long as they identify as female we will welcome them

- Goal to make all of our services as effective as possible would be facilitated by an outside person

#### Sarah:

 Have reached out to two individuals to facilitate - both will be submitting proposals within the next week

Sr. Marilyn: time commitment by the Board?

Sarah: Yes—some pre-work, homework, then a possible full day session

Sr. Marilyn: with the losses, additions, and the social transition the situation has been altered - agree that an internal review/assessment is timely

Bill: Development committee meeting was educational - has been good to get a sense of the needs for the team and a more efficient ways of reaching a broader audience

Sarah: Would want to encourage Board members to think of 5 people that could support FM from a development perspective - Sarah could invite these individuals to FM for an informational session - Bill calls it "friend-raising": networking in a way to gather and learn about the organization, be introduced to personnel in a non-pushy way
