Henderson Lake Property Owners:

It has been a pleasure managing Henderson Lake this summer. Every year seems to bring a unique set of challenges and we welcome the opportunity to meet these challenges every single year. We hope that you continue to feel that your lake was managed professionally, economically, and effectively.

As we wrap up the 2015 season, we are happy to give you a brief re-cap of the treatments that were performed on Henderson Lake. This year, we treated Henderson Lake (3) times as follows:

On June 15th, 2015 Savin Lake Services conducted our initial treatment for the non-native invasive plant communities of Eurasian Watermilfoil, and Curly Leaf Pondweed anywhere they were present in the lake. Also during this treatment we conducted an Algae treatment and treated for nuisance native vegetation with contact herbicides in and around docks and out to the (5) foot depth contour in developed areas. During this application we found and treated (2.5) acres of Eurasian Watermilfoil (treated systemically), and (5) acres of Curly Leaf Pondweed. We also conducted an Algae treatment over (27) acres of the lake, and treated (26.5) acres of native pondweeds like Large Leaf Pondweed, and Richardson's Pondweed in the developed areas where they were reaching a nuisance level.

On July 27th, 2015 Savin Lake Services conducted our mid-summer treatment for Algae, any residual vegetation in and around docks and out to the (5) foot depth contour in developed areas. In addition to the aquatic weed and algae control, we also did a Bacterial Augmentation treatment on (2.5) acres of the lake. During this application we conducted an Algae treatment over (27) acres of the Lake, and treated (20) acres for nuisance vegetation like Bladderwort, Large Leaf Pondweed, and Floating Leaf Pondweed.

Our last treatment for the season took place on September 1st, 2015. This treatment consisted of an algae treatment, emergent control, and another Bacterial Augmentation application. During this application we conducted another Algae treatment over (17) acres of the lake, and treated emergents like Lily pads, cattails, bulrush, etc. in areas approved by the DEQ. We also did another Bacterial Augmentation treatment in the same (2.5) acre area we did on the July 27th application, the product is recommended for best result to do 2-3 treatments per season every 4-6 weeks.
