Above: High winds caused a cooking fire to get out of control, resulting in about 70 homes (huts) being destroyed in the village of Reddipalem. We have 15 elderly and handicapped believers who are part of a Manna Program in this village. The government has been feeding them, and is promising them new cement homes. Whatever relief funds we receive, we will use for clothes, cooking vessels and other needed items. Pray.

NEED FOR ANOTHER SCHOOL CLASSROOM: Isaac and Smitha, who run the HOPE School, have asked that we build another classroom for the school. The roof and flooring is already there, so the main need is for brick walls. For perhaps \$2,000 or less, we can build some walls for another classroom, which helps much during the rainy or windy seasons. If more funds come, we can include a door and windows.

Below: These are 9 of at least 24 elderly who are asking us for help. They are all professing believers, living near our widows home in Chinthayapalem. They were all being supported by another organization, but recently that organization ran into financial trouble, and was no longer able to support them. We are praying and trusting the Lord for His guidance in these matters. It's really tough turning people away who are in need.



CHILDREN'S PROFILES

Nehemia (born 12-10-07, Morning Star): Her father is one of the Morning Star pastors. They lost everything in their home during a mass persecution years ago. Hindus caught them and forced them to drink cow dung water, commanding them to convert to Hinduism, but they would not. They were beaten, threatened, and left in poverty, but the Lord has been faithful to care for their family. Nehemia came to MS in 2013. A happy girl, but physically weak.



Susmitha (born 9-21-10, new girl in HOPE): Susmitha's parents were often quarreling, which intensified when Susmitha's hand was burned in a fire, the father blaming the mother for carelessness. He abandoned the family about 3 years ago. The mother was trying to work and provide for 2 children, supposedly no one to care for them while she worked. Susmitha came to HOPE earlier this month. A very bright little girl.

Sruthi (9-21-11, new girl in HOPE): Sruthi comes from a very poor home, her father dying with tuberculosis. The mother was left with 2 small girls to care for. In India culture, it's almost impossible for this mother to get remarried in a way that is culturally acceptable. Sruthi came to HOPE earlier in July. She's a very cute girl; everyone likes her and enjoys playing with her. "And all your children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of your children." Isaiah 54:13



Aksha (8-23-10, new girl in HOPE): This girl, Aksha, comes from a Muslim family. The father died at a young age, his lungs somehow spoiled due to heavy drinking. The mother is struggling to try and work, and provide for 2 children. Aksha came to HOPE earlier this month. A sweet girl and adjusting well. We are thankful for the Lord granting us little ones who are from both Hindu and Muslim backgrounds, giving them the chance to learn about Him.

ALL MY BONES WILL SAY...

"All my bones will say, 'Lord, who is like You, delivering the afflicted from him who is too strong for him, the afflicted and needy from him who robs him.'" Psalms 35:10

Our Lord and Father is truly amazing! David cried, *"When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars which You have ordained, what is man that You are mindful of him? And the son of man, that You care for him?" Psalms 8:3-4.* In Psalms 113 the song-writer says, *"The Lord is high above all nations; His glory is above the heavens. Who is like the Lord our GOD, who is enthroned on high, who humbles Himself to behold the things that are in heaven and in the earth?"* Wow, He "humbles Himself" to even look at us! MANNA PROGRAM PROFILES

LAKSHMAAMMA (Reddipalem MP): Comes from a Hindu background, but has been attending churches for about 30 years. Her husband is around 80, she in her 70's. Both are having health issues, not able to work to provide for their needs. She is one of the elderly to lose her home in the recent fire in Reddipalem (front page story). *"O Lord, You know the hopes of the helpless. Surely You will listen to their cries and comfort them."* Psalms 10:17



ESWARAMMA (El Bethel MP): She is in her 80's. Her husband died in 2008; she has 3 children, the 2 sons alcoholics and not caring for her properly. She stays with her daughter, who's a good believer. The son-in-law attends prayers, but has been in bondage to drinking and not working faithfully to provide for the family. Both she and her daughter have diabetes. Pray for the El Bethel Manna Program. The pastor says there are about 10 more elderly believers who are in need, scattered in different villages.
