(1) Cl. 7-0, Small. Glass specialized to pictorials. Label glass type and pictorial class. In Memory of Dorothy Tunison, Bruce Noland Cole, \$10 -7-3

(2) Cl. 9-0, 25 Any Size. Horn assorted. L. A. Button Club, \$12-8-5

(3) Cl. 10.1 thru 10.10 + 23-4.1.3, Large. Metal with pictorial borders including integrated. No OME or DF. Include as many pictorial borders (Sects. 17 thru 20) and different metals as possible. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15-10-5

(4) Cl. 10-5 + 10-8, Small. Buttons of steel metal and brass metal specialized to original tint. OME and other DF allowed. Consider labeling buttons with these counter points. No balance between brass and steel buttons required. Ricki Nichols, \$10-7-3

(5) Cl. 10-9, 25 Any Size. Copper specialized to 18thc. copper metal. Label DF and OME. In Loving Memory of Tom Barrans, \$25-15-10

(6) Cl. 11-0, Small. Shell assorted. Ricki Nichols, \$10-7-3

(7) Cl. 17-2, 25 Any Size. Birds assorted. Long Beach Button Club, In memory of Dorothy Tunison, \$10-7-3

(8) Cl. 17-4.3.1, Med/Lg. Butterflies/moths. No caterpillars or chrysalis allowed. Long Beach Button Club, \$10-7-3

(9) Cls. 23-1.1 + 23-1.2 + 23-1.7, 25 Any size. Backgrounds specialized to celluloid, fabric and galena. Must have at least five of each. Include both pictorial and non-pictorial. Consider labeling background material to aid in judging. Wild About Buttons, \$10-7-3

(10) Cl. 23-6.3 L, Large. Gay 90s. Limited to those who have not won a blue ribbon in this class. Inland Empire Button Club, \$15-10-5

DIV. II

(11) Cl. 1-3 + 1-6.2, Medium. US uniform buttons Federal government agencies non-military (Albert FD) and National armed forces. Try for balance. Label usage. In Memory of Conrad Flake, Bruce Noland Cole, \$10-7-3

(12) Cl. 1-6 + 2-4, 30 Medium. US Military (armed forces) and Foreign Military (armed forces). Specialized to numbered units/regiments. Ten each of United States, Great Britain, Other Foreign. Label usage. **Keith and Georgia Bryce Memorial Award.** Long Beach Button Club \$5-3-2

(13) Cl. 1-10, Medium. U.S transportation uniform buttons. Try for balance. Label usage i.e. air, land, rail, services, street, water). **CSBS Awards Chair Award**, Carol Cienna, \$15-6-4

DIV. III

(14) Cl. 2-2.1, 25 Any Size. Aritas. No limit on realistics. Long Beach Button Club, \$10-7-3

(15) Cl. 6-0 L, Mixed. Black glass assorted. Label and mount in order. Limited to people who have competed 5 years or less. In Loving Memory of Myron Johnson (CSBS), \$10-7-3

(16) Cl. *6-0 + 7-0, Small. Glass buttons specialized to Art Deco design. Okay to include *black glass but not required. Ricki Nichols, \$10-7-3

(17) Cl. 7-3.2, 25 Any Size. Transparent specialized to green glass. DF encouraged. No OME allowed. L.A. Button Club, \$12-8-5

(18) Cl. 12-1.3 25 Any Size. Phenolic resin. Try for a variety of colors, shapes, pictorials, OME. Long Beach Button Club, \$10-7-3

(19) Cl. 17.0 thru 20-24, 25 Any Size. Pictorials relating to things/people/characters/food/rides/animals found at Disneyland/California Adventure, excluding Star Wars and Marvel. Disney buttons not required but use if you have them. Label each button for connection to Disneyland/California Adventure, i.e. a teacup to represent the Teacup ride. Try for as many different materials as possible. No balance between Sections necessary. Orange County Button Club, \$10-7-3

(20) Cl. 21-1, 35 Any Size. Pictorial summary specialized to buttons painted by Edith & Alan Brooks ("Brooks buttons"). Label and mount in class number order. Please additionally label rare buttons (various sizes, materials other than casein). ABC Button Club (San Mateo), \$20-10-5

DIV. IV

(21) Cl. 2.1, 6 Any. Buckles/clasps type specialized to mammals. Note: if there are multiple animals on a buckle, all must be mammals. Ronnie Wexler, \$15-10-5

DIV. IX

(22) Cl. 1-0 thru 15-5, 24 Any Size. Materials assorted specialized to hare/rabbits and tortoise/turtles. Although preferred, both animals need not be on the same button. Label material and back marks. No limit to realistics or studios. In Memory of Ruth and Bob Denison of the San Diego Button Club, Sandy Gaudur, \$15-10-5

(23) Cl. 1-0 thru 15-5, 25 Any Size. Materials assorted specialized to frogs/toads. Sandy Gaudur, \$15-10-5

(24) Cl. 1-1.2.4, 25 Any Size. Celluloid tight tops specialized to non-pictorial designs (i.e. Geometric, quilt-like, circles, patterns, etc.). Ricki Nichols, \$10-7-3

(25) Cl. 1-6.2, Small. Celluloid "glows". For definition see p. 34 Blue Book. Ricki Nichols, \$10-7-3

(26) Cl. 2-0, 25 Any Size. Ceramics. No studio buttons. Johnny & Louie Memorial Award (Long Beach Button Club), \$25-15-10

(27) Cl. 4-0, 20 Any Size. Enamels Assorted. Orange County Button Club, \$10-7-3

(28) Cl. 6-6.7, 25 Any Size. Black Glass Lacy-Lacy like. Look for different luster/colored wash DF. Also, 2 point bonus for each matching pair; see definition of matching pairs on pg. 4 of Blue Book. Jane Ford Adams Memorial Award (San Diego Button Club), \$25-15-10

(29) Cl. 7-2, Medium. Clear colorless glass specialized to silver luster DF. Wild About Buttons, \$10-7-3

(30) Cl. 7-3, 25 Any Size. Glass, clear and colored. Specialized to all values of blue, no blue-green. Verbal labeling (pictorials, shapes, back types, OME, DF, etc.) recommended but not required. Modesto Button Club, In Memory of our member Mary Kay Mancebo, \$12-8-5

(31) Cl. 7-4.1 thru 7-4.15, 25 Any Size. Clear & colored glass, construction assorted. Read BB, p.41, carefully. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15-10-5

(32) Cl. 8.0, 25 Any Size. Glass mounted in/on metal assorted. No studio buttons. Long Beach Button Club, \$10-7-3

(33) Cl. 12-1, 25 Any Size. Unlisted specialized to "Junque Deco" buttons. Look for shapes, different color background and different inclusions. This type of button is considered "embedded" (see Cl. 12-10.7). Ricki Nichols, \$10-7-3

(34) Cl. 17-0, 20 Any Size. Animals that have been pets in the White House during a Presidency. Label the animal and the name of the President who was in the White House at the time. No limit on realistics. Sonoma County Button Club, \$25-15-10

(35) Cl. 17-4.3.1 Various. Insects specialized to Butterflies (no moths). No larvae or caterpillars. Limit of 1 studio. In honor of Mother Nature. **CSBS Brief Editor Award**, L. Renée Comeau, \$15-10-5

(36) Cl. 18-0 thru 20-24, 25 Any Size. Specialized to things one would find in a high school Home Economics classroom. Look for a variety of subject matter and materials. No limit on realistics. Verbal labeling recommended. Modesto Button Club, In Memory of our member Yvonne Jones, \$10-8-6

(37) Cl. 18-4, 25 Any Size. Containers. Try for the largest selection of different types of containers as well as materials. **CSBS Treasurer's Award**, Marion Nebiker, \$25-15-10

(38) Cl. 18-6.4, 25 Any Size. Hats, headdresses specialized to crowns. May include people or other pictorials but crown must be identifiable. Santa Clara Valley Button Club, \$15-10-5

(39) Cl. 18-12 + 20-22.1.1, 25 Any Size. Specialized to maps and ships (large river and sea vessels), at least 10 of each. Jane Quimby, In Honor of Adventurers, \$10-7-3

(40) Cl. 19-2.6, 25 Any. Specialized to Pansies and Violas. No balance necessary. Limited to no more than 5 studio buttons. No uniform buttons allowed. Limited to those who have not won in this category before. Orange County Button Club, \$10-7-3

(41) Cl. 19-6, 25 Any Size. Clovers/shamrocks with or without stem. Pictorial elements allowed but clovers/shamrocks must be focus. No limit on realistic. Maximum of three studio buttons. **CSBS Vice President Award**, Nancy Wilson, \$25-15-10

(42) Cl. 20-0, Various. Other Pictorials Assorted. Label and mount in class order. No studio buttons and no uniform buttons allowed. In Loving Memory of Gloria Vick (L.A. Button Club), \$12-8-5

(43) CL. 20-2, Various. Asian/Oriental. For purposes of this award, consider Asian/Oriental to be Japanese and Chinese pictorials. Renée Comeau, \$20-10-5

(44) Cl. 20-6, Various. Cupids, cherubs, putti (no angels). Limit 1 studio button. In Honor of those who volunteer time and effort in support of CSBS activities, Renée Comeau, \$20-10-5

(45) Cl. 20-8, 25 Any Size. Specialized to 20 dragons, 5 fabulous animals. Up to 5 studio buttons allowed. San Diego Button Club, \$15-10-5

(46) Cl. 20-10, 25 Any Size. Heads specialized to women's or men's heads with hats, including headdress, which must include a feather or feathers. No balance required between women's and men's heads. Consider labeling materials, back marks, DF, OME to aid in judging. Hooked on Buttons, \$10-7-3

(47) Cl. 20-23, 25 Any Size. Lovely ladies specialized to full-figured. Multiple women fine but no children. Sandy Gaudur, \$15-10-5

(48) Cl. 21-2, Large. Pictorial summary, animals (Sect. 17) and plants (Sect. 19). Label and mount in class order. Must include 10 each from the two listed sections. In Honor of Betty Jewel for her dedication to our hobby (CSBS), \$15-10-5

(49) Cl. 22-1, 20 Any Size. Patterns assorted specialized to celluloid wafers. Verbally label buttons as to pattern, but no penalty for mislabeled patterns. Be sure you select wafers and take care not to include pictorials. Tom & Barbara Barrans, \$10-7-3

(50) Cl. 23-2.4, 25 Any Size. Paris back marks, assorted materials. In honor of my Grandson, Travis Gomez and his fiancé, Kirsty Ronquillo. **CSBS President's Award**, Susan Porter, \$25-15-10

(51) Cl. 23-4, Med/Large. Borders assorted. Try to cover all the subclasses. No balance between subclasses required. Labeling of materials, back marks, OME, DF and any other counters as an aid to judges is useful. Limit of three studio buttons. Inland Empire Button Club, \$15-10-5

(52) Cls. 23-10.2.1 + 23-10.2.2. 25 Any Size. Must include 10 oval, 10 squares (including modified), plus 5 free choice within the specified classes. San Diego Button Club, \$15-10-5
