

- Pool hours are 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Use of pool is limited to owners, their families, guests and renters. Each unit shall have no more than six (6) persons represented in the pool area.
- No food or drinks allowed in pool or around the pool area. Food is permitted at the picnic tables. All drinks must be in non-breakable containers. No Glass!!
- Due to limited number of lounge chairs, do not monopolize same by placing towels on chairs for an extended period (more than 30 minutes) when left unattended.
- No running or rough play around or in the pool will be permitted.
- No flippers, floats or inner tubes are allowed in pool.
- Poolside furniture must not be taken to the beach or removed from the pool area.
- Do not place dirty diapers in the pool area trash can. They should be placed into a plastic baggie and dropped down the trash chute.
- The two umbrellas will be closed and tied when not in use. This is everyone's responsibility.
- Children must be able to swim to use adult pool. Babies and small children who are not toilet trained and/or wear diapers (despite the use of plastic or rubber pants) are not allowed in adult pool.
- Nothing is to be left in the pool area overnight. If beach chairs, boogie boards, floats, fishing poles, etc. are left out in the pool area overnight, they will be discarded the next morning.

LIGHTS OUT FOR SEA TURTLES

Everyone is to abide by the Volusia County lighting regulations during sea turtle nesting season which runs from May 1 through October 31:

- Keep balcony lights turned off during the nesting season.
- Draw drapes or blinds at night if your room is lighted.
