I hope this newsletter finds you well.

Yesterday afternoon the Lutheran pastors and some lay leaders met via Zoom with Bishop Andy to discuss reopening our congregations here in Hawaii. The bishop was there to listen to where we were at here in the islands. Since each church has its own unique context, we were, of course, all over the place. Some churches have begun meeting. Some are planning to open soon. Others are waiting until September.

Where is Christ Lutheran regarding this re-gathering of our faithful? Regarding in-person worship on the CLC campus: At this time no decision has been made to "re-open" the campus. We will definitely not be gathering in person this Sunday, Pentecost. Church will remain open via social media, especially Zoom and FaceBook. You can also participate through audio recordings on Sound Cloud and audio-visual recordings on YouTube.

Christ Lutheran's Church Council is meeting this Sunday, May 31st, to discuss how and when to return to inperson worship. Many of the details for how CLC returns have been thought through and many of those have been already put in place. Suffice to say we are following the advice of scientists and public health experts and they are telling us it is not safe ... not quite yet So, stay tuned!

Additionally, Bishops Taylor, Erwin and Holmerud, the bishops of California and Hawaii, are also advising us not to resume in-person worship until said scientific and medical experts believe it is safe.
