#### **Registration / Timeline:**

- Online Registration is open.
- Lake goes **OFF-LIMITS** at midnight Wednesday the 9<sup>th</sup> until 5am Saturday the 12<sup>th</sup> of April.
- Official Practice Day will be Saturday April 12<sup>th</sup> from 5am until 7pm.

# Lake Belton is currently 2.95 feet low. Water Temperature is 63 degrees and stained. Fishing is reported to be fair.

Extreme caution must be used while on the water.

Sunday 13 April 2025:

**Tournament Day** 

- 1) Launch
- This will **NOT** be a **TRAILERING EVENT**.
- Other available ramps are: Arrowhead Park, Arrowhead Point Road, Belton, Texas 76513
  (2 lane boat ramp) BLORA, Cottage Road, Belton, Texas 76513
  (2 lane boat ramp) Frank's Marina, 3260 Lake Park Road, Belton, Texas 76513
  (1 lane boat ramp) Westcliff Park, Westcliff Road, Belton, Texas 76513
  (2 lane boat ramp) Reminder, you may use one of these other ramps, but you will need to come to the official launch site for the numbered launch
- The Official Launch site will be Temple Lake Park Boat Ramp.
- The Official Launch Time will be Safe Light (about 7am). You may put in beginning at 5:00am.
- Check-in and Boat Number draw will begin at 5:45am, at the Official Launch Site, the Temple Lake Park Boat Ramp.

- First cast will be at 7:00am. An orderly take-off is a must. All boats will stage to the right of the boat ramp prior to launch.
- Teams that do not come to the weigh-in site must text 254-368-0294 once they have concluded their day of fishing and are off the water.
- All Boat Captains need to be mine full of the <u>"No-Wake Zones"</u> and be sure you are not cutting off other anglers as you leave the ramp area.
- All Boat Captains must observe any, and all posted "No Fishing Areas" / "No Boat Areas."
- Randum Live-well checks will be conducted at the ramp the morning of the tournament.

#### 2) <u>Weigh-In</u>

- The Official Weigh-in site will be the Temple Lake Park Group Pavilion.
- The Scales will open at 2:00pm.
- Anglers must be in line by 2:30pm with their catch. Any angler coming in after the 2:30pm cut-off will incur a late penalty. If a team reports 15 minutes or more late for weigh-in, that team will be disqualified from the event and their weight will not count.
- For safety reasons and to comply with the Youth Safe Sport Act, all boats must have <u>3 people on the</u> <u>boat, 2 student anglers and a Boat Captain</u>. If for whatever reason an angler cannot make it, that team must provide an observer.

#### <u>Awards</u>

- Scholarships, Trophies, and Prizes will be awarded after the weigh-in has concluded (beginning at approximately 2:45pm).
- Awards will be given to the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place Teams, including Big Bass, plus additional award / prizes for each 10 entries.
- Awards for the heaviest sack will be given to the Top True Junior Angler Team.
  - a) A **TRUE** Junior Angler Teams are those teams in which both anglers are in grades  $6^{th} 8^{th}$ .
