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1. Call meeting to order

61	Chair Bennett read the item and stated that Town Planner Jim Smith was not able to be at the		
62	meeting, but that he is in full support of moving forward with the study based on the		
63	suggestion of the Planning Commission and would recommend the Council approve		
64	commencing with the study. Town Clerk Spelorzi stated that Mr. Smith has been in touch		
65	with a representative from FDOT on this topic.		
66	Discussion ensued about the footage requirements and that they will go into effect for all new		
67	roads or any existing roads that are being paved.		
68	Councilmember Herbert Bennett made the motion to approve proceeding with a set-		
69	back requirement study; seconded by Vice Chair James Peterson. All agreed; motion
