Notes: The meet was moved to Dickinson from Jamestown due to snow and wet course conditions there...Williston won its second straight WDA team title and ninth overall...Dickinson's Brady Yoder won his second consecutive WDA title...Seven teams (Bismarck High, Century, Dickinson, Jamestown, Legacy, Minot, Williston) had at least one runner earn all-WDA honors (Top 20)...Century had seven runners finish in the top 20...Williston's Micade Shumway was named W. Region senior athlete of the year...Century's Brad Lies was named W. Region coach of the year...There were 157 runners competing...Temperature at race time was 45 degrees under mostly cloudy skies
