## A Note from our Pastor

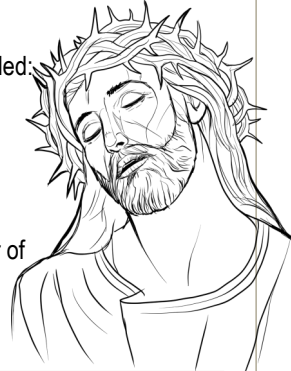
As we begin our Lenten Devotions I would like to encourage you to participate in two Lenten talks this year to respond positively to Jesus' call to prayer.

## RCIA News!

For the next three Sundays, (March 7th at 9:00 am, March 14th at 11:30 am, and March 20th at 5:30 pm) the Elect (unbaptized) will celebrate the Scrutinies. The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults calls for us to solemnly celebrate the scrutiny rite on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent. These scrutinies are prayers meant to uncover and heal all that is weak, sinful, and defective in the hearts of the elect, then strengthen all that is upright, strong and good. They complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ. We celebrate the Scrutinies with the Gospel readings of the woman at the well, the man born blind and the raising of Lazarus. We examine our lives in light of the Gospel teachings which are so rich in helping us to discern the call to discipleship.
