



Zoom Meeting Minutes February 2, 2021

Zoom meeting with seven participants.

Treasurer reports that bank balance is at \$20,211.15.

Had a \$2000.00 gold level membership donation from Rocky Mountain Rentals.

We raised \$809.00 from our Steamboat Vintage Snowmobile food concession booth.

We are still waiting for our grant money request from the Quaeley and Divide trail work for approximately \$10k to arrive from the state.

We currently have 34 paid members which is about normal, go to our Facebook page or web site to join.

Of the \$16,000 in our grooming fund managed by the State Parks, we have spent \$2400 to date.

January 12th was our first real grooming run as snow cover was adequate enough. The total hours to date on the groomer are 73.

We are still having electrical issues on the groomer and have requested a repair tech from Grand Junction. The windshield is cracked enough to merit replacement by Geiger Glass, Mark is handling the coordination of the repairs.

The trail markers are out on most of the trails with the Divide and 42 trail still needing poles placed.

We have a Twitter page (<https://twitter.com/LakeSteamboat>) for the snow club that has a link to the SPOT on the snowcat to let everyone know when trails are being groomed. Specific information on which trails are groomed are also posted on Twitter. Also, the parking information on the quarry lot is posted and updated to redirect users to the Marina lot if the Quarry lot is full.

Brett Allison from the Rotary Club spoke about a Poker Run Fundraiser to be held on March 20th. This is a new event to raise money for the snow club as well as Lift Up and other non-profits in town. Carol has offered to have the Hahn's Peak Roadhouse host an afternoon Barbeque and silent auction at the culmination of the Poker Run. The silent auction should be a good way to help support businesses around the area. We are looking for some sponsors to help support the event.
