Regular Meeting ----- March 14, 1991

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, ATTENDANCE D. L. Taylor at 7:00 A.M. at the District office. Other Board members present were Bobbie Domenick, John Groo, Karl Tangren, James Walker, Dave Maki, and Gary Wilson.

Special Service District members present were Gary Wilson, Dan Holyoak, and George White.

Others present were Mark Page, Bob Byrnes, Steve Olschewski, Marsha Modine, Dale Pierson and Roberta Highland.

After calling for additions or corrections to the MINUTES minutes of the meeting of February 28, 1991 and hearing none, the Chair declared the minutes approved as circulated to the Board.

The bids for the new truck were opened and read as TRUCK BIDS follows:

Gary moved to accept the Chevrolet bid. Dan seconded.

The bids for the computer were opened and read as COMPUTER BIDS follows:

Gary moved to buy the Petra Computer. John seconded.

Mark Page gave an overview of past history of Moab MARK PAGE Irrigation Co. Change Applications and water rights. informed the Board members that when a change application is received they evaluate how it applies to the original right. That evaluation can be reviewed. Mark suggested additional points of diversion. In answer to a question, he stated a change application be made by the district for the two mesas, and Horse Creek. In answer to a question by Olschewski about a partial re-conveyance, Mark replied they did not use that re-conveyance because it was not a water deed. The stipulation in the original deed is that when the project is paid for, the District will give the Company a Water Deed to re-convey that right back to Moab Irrigation Co. The Agreement with the Moab Irrigation Co and the Conservancy District was discussed. After a lengthy Discussion it was agreed that Mark Page would put his understanding of the situation in writing to the Irrigation Company and to the Conservancy District, and then the Company and the District will sign a memorandum of understanding between the

Company and the District. D. L. asked about the District's MARK PAGE position when the water rights are deeded back to the Moab (Cont.) Irrigation Co. Mark stated the District would become a shareholder in the company with all attendant rights. Acreage necessary to keep the perfected right was discussed, and it was reported the District currently sells irrigation water to 735 acres, and that we should sell to 840 acres as sole supplier. The vast majority of the 735 acres presently sold to also have well rights. Mark suggested this acreage be looked it with an eye to readjudication.

Dale reported the public hearing for the CIB Grant PROPOSED CIB has been noticed, and will be included in the next meeting. GRANT HEARING

George moved to approve the checks as written. CHECK APPROVAL Bobbie seconded.

Dan suggested we look into buying the state land PURCHASE DAM we lease for the dam site. He was authorized to investigate SITE this possibility.

Dale reported the last snow survey he got showed SNOW SURVEY 82% of normal. The report generated locally showed 100% last Friday. Gary moved to let the present situation regarding availability stand. The District has notified customers that if any restrictions are imposed, they will be notified.

D. L. stated Jim Walker had wanted the two Boards JOINT MEETING get together tomorrow with full boards. Dale mentioned this WITH M.I.C. Board will have to give notice to have a legal meeting and make decision.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 A.M.
