Concert Band Syllabus 2023

Concert Band Registration Fee: \$275.00/Concert Band

CLASSES

B100A (Grade Seven): Select three contrasting compositions and/or arrangements that are classified as grade one concert band repertoire. This class is for school concert bands whose members are currently enrolled in grade seven.

B100B (Grade Eight): Select three contrasting compositions and/or arrangements that are classified as grade one concert band repertoire. This class is for school concert bands whose members are currently enrolled in grade eight.

B200: Select three contrasting compositions and/or arrangements that are classified as grade two concert band repertoire.

B300: Select three contrasting compositions and/or arrangements that are classified as grade three concert band repertoire.

B400: Select three contrasting compositions and/or arrangements that are classified as grade four concert band repertoire.

Open Community Concert Band: Open for community concert bands.

AWARDS

Commemorative Plaque for the top band in each concert band class. Gold Medal Awards for top individual performers. Additional Awards/Scholarships may be announced.

CONCERT BAND RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Concert Bands may enter <u>one</u> Class.

2. Concert Bands must complete their online registration, and include accurate times for the selections performed.

3. Concert Bands must arrive <u>30 minutes</u> prior to their performance time, and stay within the practice/pre-performance room until they are called up on stage by the stage manager.

4. Concert Bands must provide a seating plan to the stage manager prior to their

performance.

5. Scores must be given to the adjudicator prior to the performance along with the band registration form. The adjudicator will return the music scores to the conductor on stage after the adjudication.

6. All concert bands will be recorded during their performance. The Band Conductor will receive a recording for the performance along with a recording of the adjudicator's comments.

7. Chairs and stands will be provided by the Creekside Theatre. The Creekside Theatre stage crew will set up the stands and chairs for each concert band prior their performance, according to the seating plans provided by the Band Conductor.

8. The adjudicator will return the music scores to the conductor on stage after the adjudication.
