Winner- B.c. by What a Pleasure- Fool-Me-Not, by Tom Fool. Trained by LeRoy Jolley; bred in Florida by Waldemar Farms, Inc. \$262,100 gross value and \$15,000 Gold Cup. Net to winner \$209,600; second \$30,000; third \$15,000; fourth \$7,500.

FOOLISH PLEASURE, away in good order, was taken under stout restraint and allowed to drop back, continued along the inside while being unhurried for five furlongs, then advanced from the inner rail after a rush, split rivals in a quick maneuver midway on the second turn, continued to advance steadily into the stretch where he was eased out wider to engage the leaders, disposed of that pair when sharply roused in midstretch and drew off under intermittent urging. AVATAR gained a forward position at once, continued slightly wide while prompting the issue down the backstretch, came on in the final turn to duel with DIABOLO for the lead, responded well after being soundly bumped and knocked off stride nearing the furlong marker by DIABOLO but was unable to stay with the winner through the final drive. DIABOLO, in hand early, moved up steadily from the outside on rounding the second turn to gain a narrow advantage, continued slightly wide while dueling for the lead until nearing the furlong marker at which point he took a bad stride to swerve into AVATAR, was in turn soundly bumped by that one and dropped back steadily thereafter. DIABOLO pulled up lame while bleeding profusely from a cut just below the knee of the left foreleg. A Stewards' Inquiry into the bumping mishap between AVATAR and DIABOLO nearing the furlong marker failed to alter the results, as it was determined DIABOLO was the originator of the bumping. MASTER DERBY, unhurried early, continued in slightly close quarters nearing the first turn, advanced from the outside through the run down the backstretch to loom boldly on entering the upper stretch only to falter through the drive. MEDIA ducked sharply to the inside soon after the start, swerved out while being straightened, improved his position steadily after three quarters, but posed no threat. PRINCE THOU ART, void of early speed, rallied from the outside on the second turn but lacked an effectual response. SYLVAN PLACE tired after being in contention a mile. FASHION SALE showed some early speed, was caught in close quarters leaving the backstretch and dropped back steadily. RUSHING MAN dropped back swiftly after being forced into the inner rail by BOMBAY DUCK leaving the backstretch. BOMBAY DUCK, sent to the fore are once, raced slightly removed from the inner rail through the run down the backstretch, cut over sharply on entering the second turn and dropped back steadily thereafter quit suddenly after setting the pace to the second turn.
