

Oregon Junior High Rodeo Ground Rules

2025-26

- Jr. high boys may enter the tie down roping and the boys breakaway roping. Boys will have to designate at time of entry which event will count for points for the entire season.
- **Contestant will only get to count points in 1 event: tie down or boys breakaway roping.**
(All points will drop down if jackpot person places in top 10)
- Ribbon roping runners may only DRAW 2 times per year and only 1 draw per weekend. The reason for this is to find a partner. Unfortunately, Oregon doesn't have a lot of boys so please do not try to enter this every weekend.
- **All contestants must keep their hat on** or be fined \$10 per lost hat.
- **In any event a contestant takes an excessive amount of time to call for their animal or enter the arena:** Contestants will be informed that they are being put on the clock, and the judge will start his stopwatch. Contestant will then have 30 seconds before the animal will be turned out or contestants will be asked to leave the area (area to be chute, box, or arena).
- **STATE FINALS** will have 30 second time limits. All other rodeos will have 45 seconds in the tie down roping, 60 seconds in team roping, and 30 in all other events unless otherwise posted.
- Boys and girls breakaway will be allowed 2 loops if you have 2 tied on loops.
- Tie down roping and ribbon roping will be 1 loop until Top 10 Round at State Finals.
- Girls and boys breakaway ropes must be tied on at the end of the rope with a knot at the end of the rope. No other options. Contestant must also use a solid color flag.
