Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Chet Owen and County Clerk, Melissa Meek

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance and led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve today's agenda and the minutes from September 5, 2023, with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor, motion carried.

Garry McFee of Howe & Company met with the Commission to advise preliminary plans for all BRO projects that have been sent in. There is no timeline yet for the projects that DeKalb County has been awarded.

Sheriff Kasey Keesaman met with the Commission to discuss staffing issues and his budget for 2024. Also discussed was the resignation of the K-9 handler and the retirement of the K-9.

A company building an apartment behind Wal-Mart asked for a letter of support from the Commission. The Commission tabled the issue at this time.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White will attend SIMS training next week. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen attended a TAC meeting, September 6, 2023, and a DeKalb County Extension meeting on Monday, September 11th.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek, gave an update on her annual Missouri County Clerk & Election Authority Conference in St. Louis, MO. There are already several candidates who have declared their candidacy for office for the August Primary. Filing for State & Local Offices does not begin until February 27, 2024, and ends March 26, 2024 with filing for County Office taking place at the Clerk's Office with the filing fee being paid to the party in which you are filing. Melissa will put more information out closer to that time. Also discussed was the need for the legislature to fix SB190. This bill impacts all taxing entities and the cost of the software to implement this bill costs thousands of dollars for each county with no clear direction or instruction on how to implement the procedure. At this time the Commission has tabled moving forward hoping the legislature will do some sort of fix to the bill.

With no other business before the Commission, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, made the motion to adjourn until September 19, 2023. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen, made the second to adjourn. All in favor, motion carried.
