## The Midwest USA Junior Gold "PREVIEW" rules.

Overview: This is a scratch bowling tournament open to any bowler age 18 and under as of August 1, 2023. The tournament will be held on Sunday, June 30, 2024 at Beaver-Vu Bowl, 1238 N. Fairfield Rd., Beavercreek (Dayton), OH. Doors open and check-in begins at 11:00 AM. Warm-ups at 11:45 AM. Tournament play begins about 12:00 PM Eastern time. There are four (4) separate divisions: 15 U boys, 15 U girls, 18 U boys, 18 U girls. Interested 12 U bowlers will be placed in the 15 U division. Bowlers will be placed in the appropriate gender division based on their age on August $1,2023$. This is not a Jr. Gold Qualifier. Any bowler (age 18 and under as of August 1, 2023) may participate. USBC Jr. Gold membership is not required to bowl in this tournament. Entries limited to $\mathbf{7 2}$ bowlers.
Format: The format is the same for all divisions. Qualifying Round: All bowlers will bowl six (6) games. Championship Round: The top 4 bowlers in each division from the Qualifying Round will advance to the Championship Round to bowl a 2-game block. After the 2 games, the field will be reduced from 4 to 2 . The 2 remain bowlers in each division will bowl 2 additional games to determine the division champion. The pattern used in each division in the Championship Round will be selected by the bowler who led their division in the Qualifying Round. Ties: Ties in either the Qualifying or Championship Round will be broken by the high game rolled in that Round.
Lane Patterns: We will apply 3 different sport patterns (used at the 2023 Jr. Gold National Championships) to our synthetic lanes. A short oil pattern, a medium oil pattern, and a long oil pattern. All bowlers will bowl two games on each of the $\mathbf{3}$ patterns in the Qualifying Round.
Cost: The pre-paid (received on or before 9:00 PM Friday, 6.28.24) entry fee is $\$ 80.00$ per bowler. An entry received after 9:00 PM Friday, 6.28.24 (accepted depending on lane availability) will be classified as a "walk-in" and assessed an additional \$10.00 late processing fee. Only paid-in-full entries will be accepted. The closing date for paid entries is prior to the start of bowling.
General Rules: Appropriate apparel is expected reflecting the high caliber of bowling anticipated. Shorts/skirts may be worn provided they pass the "fingertip-length" test. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder or any foreign substance on equipment, shoes, the approach, or on the facility floor or carpet is not permitted. The bowling ball surface may only be altered prior to the start of the Qualifying Round. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowling area. The bowler, by voluntary participation in the event, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Manager to make necessary on-site changes and to interpret and enforce all rules, regulations, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation(s) will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretative judgment guided by the best interest of youth bowling and this event. USBC Rule 400 will be observed.
Awards: The number of SMART scholarships awarded in each division will be based on the number of paid entries in each division. No fewer than 1:6 bowlers in each division will receive a SMART scholarship. NOTE: The Midwest USA \$cholarship Tournaments will provide \$30.00 per bowler to the total scholarships awarded. All scholarship funds will be sent to the SMART Program (\#08871) for management and dispersal.
