A. Virgil C. Webb

Virgil C. Webb was a life-long resident of Bondurant, Iowa. He farmed his family farm and eventually was the rural postal carrier later in his life. He enjoyed music by singing in church and for others. He was known for his generosity by giving away his sweet corn and his garden products, all renowned for their taste, quality and size. Virgil realized he would not outlive his investments and requested his family holdings be invested in the Bondurant community. His first concern was for graduates from Bondurant-Farrar High School who wanted to go to college for music and had financial limitations. He was also concerned for financially needy and deserving graduates of Bondurant-Farrar High School, who wish to attend a four-year college or university majoring in something other than music.

B. General Information

The Virgil C. Webb, William Garber and Flora Webb Garber Foundation ("Foundation") was initiated to provide scholarships to financially needy and deserving senior graduates from Bondurant-Farrar High School. First consideration for the scholarships is financial need. Scholarship is not available for internet based colleges/universities. This scholarship will cease in 2028.

Only complete applications will be considered

- Scholarship is available to only accredited four year college or university in the United States.
- The scholarship may cover tuition and fees for up to 30 credit hours per academic year.
- The scholarship is available for undergraduate studies during the first four years after graduation from high school.
- Applicant must reside in the 2009 Bondurant-Farrar Community School District.
- Scholarship renewal application consists of:
 - o Financial information including:
 - FAFSA Student Aid Index (SAI) and FAFSA Submission Summary, including scholarships and amounts
 - Student and parent financial statements (forms included in application)
 - Signed student and parent tax returns for prior year (2024)
 - Official transcript from college/university (see Consent to Release of Grades and Academic Information)
 - o Consent to Release of Grades and Academic Information

The scholarship award winner must

- provide a fall semester schedule of classes and statement of student accounts (Ubill) showing amount due. The Foundation will fund to the lesser of the amount due for tuition, books and fees or amount due.
- maintain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 in all coursework
- complete a minimum of 12 hours per semester credit hours (credit hour is class hours figured into the GPA). Class hours are not necessarily credit hours (pass/fail/audit classes are not credit hours.)
- continue to be a student in good standing by abiding by the policies of the college or university
- fulfill the academic responsibilities of the award
- provide semester grade results, spring UBill and the spring college class schedule to the Managing Directors of the Foundation after the fall semester.
- applicant must be a citizen of the United States

Scholarship renewal applicants are asked to submit a completed application by June 30th of each year. The application will be reviewed by the Managing Directors and approved by the Board of Directors of the Foundation. The application will be scored. Scholarship awards will be limited in 2025-2026 to funds allocated and quality and quantity of applications. Additional information may be requested and a personal interview may be required. The scholarship award winners will be notified by mail.

Applications must be postmarked no later than June 30th of each year. Mail completed applications to: Virgil C. Webb, William Garber and Flora Webb Garber Foundation, 5360 NE 70th Ave., Altoona, IA 50009-9564. Only complete applications will be considered.

C. Award Amounts

Award amounts may vary with each student. Students who qualify and are selected will be awarded scholarship funds. The Managing Directors supervise these student award accounts. If a student drops below full time designation, or drops from the college or university during the refund period, the Foundation may request a refund of the scholarship from the college/university. A student in good standing who has fulfilled previous award obligations may apply each year for the award. Preference will be given first to high school graduates and then to college students requesting a renewal of the award or a new application for existing college student. Award determination will not be discussed.

D. Scholarship Payment -

Awarded scholarships will be paid by semester. A student qualifies each semester. The first award payment will be one-half of the total award (1/3 for trimesters) after August 10. Students must submit the fall semester schedule and Ubill prior to submission of funds to the college/university. The second semester award payment (and third for trimesters) will be made after the Foundation receives the student's fall grade report, Ubill and class schedule for the spring semester. The following factors may be grounds for discontinuing the award: the student's failure to maintain minimum grade point average; the student's failure to carry and complete 12 credit hours per semester (college credit hour is completed class hours computed in grade point average, not class hours), the inability of the student to work harmoniously with faculty and/or fellow students; and the student's failure to make significant progress toward a degree; or a serious violation of the law or of the college/ university policies and regulations. The Board of Directors of the Foundation reserves the right to refuse a semester payment or renewal. Students may re-apply for this award so long as they have complied with the conditions of the award and there are funds allocated by the Foundation. Renewal is not automatic for this scholarship. If an award is issued, a class schedule for the fall semester is due by August 1, as well as the student account statement showing amount due for the semester. Amounts funded for the scholarship will be the lesser of the scholarship or amounts due on the statement of student accounts from the university/college.
