Guidelines.

1. Please condense the information about your proposal so that it fits within the space allowed on the application form.

2. You may submit additional information as an addendum to the proposal, but it is essential that all pertinent information be included on the application form within the space provided.

3. The foundation provides grants for any person who wishes to pursue the preservation of Scottish cultural heritage such as but not limited to dancing, piping, drumming, fiddling, harping, etc. As a general rule, the trustees will not make grants for recurring expenses such as but not limited to: clothing, instrument purchases, upkeep, or repairs, dues, annual operating expenses, or debt incurred from said activities and we prefer to make grants of a non-recurring nature.

4. A report must be provided by the grantee, which demonstrates that the project has been completed.

Further funding will not be considered until evidence of completion of the project is received.
5. The foundation's fiscal year runs from May 1st through April 30th. Potential applicants should submit applications prior to March 31st of the calendar year.

6. Please be sure to complete all information requested on the grant application and the preparer must sign the application.
