Please fill out the enclosed nomination form and return it with your original breeding certificates. Each consignment must include a check for \$50 per lot. Futurity heifers are an additional \$200/hfr. These fees are non-refundable. If for any reason you do not bring the animal to the sale or the animal is cut from the sale the nomination fee will be forfeited and will be applied to sales expenses.

The nomination deadline is March 3, 2025. Bulls will be limited to 5 or less.

Guidelines for the Southern Alliance Beefmaster Sale

Nomination Deadline is March 3, 2025.

The catalog fee is \$50/head for registered lots and the catalog fee for commercial cattle is \$20/head. NON-REFUNDABLE

Consignment must consist of the following:

Completed and signed consignment form

Nomination Fee - \$50 per lot NON-REFUNDABLE

Commercial Fee - \$20 per head — NON-REFUNDABLE

Futurity Premium - \$200 per heifer NON-REFUNDABLE

This fee must accompany all consignments - No Exceptions)

Breeding Certificates (Original)

Footnotes are optional but we recommend footnotes.

Health Papers - All cattle must meet health state requirements and be listed on a current health certificate. Palpation on females must be shown on the health certificate. Testing must be done within 30 days of sale date. On non-vaccinated females, we recommend they be brucellosis tested if they are test age eligible. All bulls must pass a Breeding Soundness Evaluation (BSE). The BSE must be filled out by a licensed Vet on the form provided by BBU or on the form issued by the Society of Theriogenology. All bulls must be Trich tested with a copy of the Trich test attached to the health paper.

The following rules apply to each category:

<u>Futurity Bred & Open Heifers:</u> The judging will select the top 3 placings in each class. The overall Grand and Reserve champions will be selected from the champions. Open heifers maximum age is 22 months. Bred heifers maximum age is 30 months. Any heifer that does not palpate safe in calf will be placed in the open category.

*This year ALL open and bred heifers are required to have weaning and yearling weights. It is recommended but not required to have them scanned as well.

**This year there will be \$1000 added to the jackpot for the Grand Champion futurity heifer!

The heifer named Miss Southern Alliance will have her picture featured in the SABMG ad in the Beefmaster Cowman.

Herd Bulls & Herd Bull Prospects: 18 months to 36 months — A total of 5 bulls will be accepted. All weights are REQUIRED for consigned bulls. It is recommended but not required to have the scan data for a consigned bull. If we exceed 5 bulls, consideration will be FIRST given to bulls with all weights and scan data after screening for conformation and quality. All bulls will be judged in one category.

ALL BULLS will be screened by video and pictures. SABMG is looking for herd bulls and herd bull prospects. Send pictures and videos to Anthony Mihalski to <u>aj1mihalski@aol.com</u>. All cattle will be screened on site again to ensure they meet sale guidelines.

<u>3-N-1's and Pairs:</u> Maximum age requirement 96 months (8 years). Any female with a calf at side that is over 6 months of age must be palpated safe in calf.

<u>Bred Heifers/Cows</u> (Maximum age for Bred heifers is 36 months/Bred cows maximum age is 72 months.) Any heifer over 24 months of age must be palpated safe in calf and all bred cows must be heavy bred and of exceptional quality.

<u>Graded Sale Open/Exposed Heifers:</u> Age limit up to 22 months of age. Any heifer that does not palpate safe in calf on the health paper will be placed in the open heifer category.

*This year ALL open and bred heifers are required to have weaning and yearling weights. It is recommended but not required to have them scanned as well.

SABMG and Sales Management reserve the right to change age limits.

If you consign a Pick of Bred or Open Heifers the Nomination Fee will be paid on all animals.

Once again, we will accept and sell commercial Beefmaster influence females. If you have a group (no singles) of at least ½ Beefmaster females you would like to consign, please contact us. We will accept open and bred heifers and young cows with calves at side (up to 2nd calf at side).

Brands on all animals must be clipped to permit proper identification. Any animal not meeting all the above listed requirements or any animal not of outstanding quality and in acceptable sale condition will be sifted and not allowed to sell.

Cattle may begin arriving the morning of Friday, May 23, 2025 and be in place by 11 AM on Friday, May 23, 2025.

Futurity Judging & Grading: Bulls and Females will be graded on Friday, May 23, 2025 at 1 p.m.

After the Grading there will be a dinner and Fun Auction to follow.

Display Pens will be available for \$100 each (if available). Please make arrangements in advance if you are interested.

Quality photos will be accepted for the catalog. Sale management will determine if they are of good enough quality for the catalog. All photos must be emailed to aj1mihalski@aol.com by April 1, 2025.
