Composition

Lack of Perspective
Lack of Texture
Poor Symmetry
Poor Framing
Distracting background and or foreground
No Use of Scale
Uninteresting Angle of View—poor viewpoint
Obstructions
No leading lines
Lacks story or interest

Use of light

Blown out Highlights
Shadows too dark--no detail (clipping)
Fill light lacking
Quality of light is either too flat, or too high contrast, or harsh
Light not interesting or distracting

Technical

Overexposed, too much light
Underexposed
Not enough light
Subject not in focus
Lack of tonal range or contrast
Scratches, dinks, Dents, physical issues
Poor color balance—color cast
Color Fringing from chromatic aberration
Over-saturated
Horizontals/verticals askew

Computer Enhancements

Over-sharpening (exhibiting halos)
Over-filtered (loss of important image detail)
Obvious cloning
Poor dodge and burn-- uneven tones and/or discoloration
Over-enlarged resulting in pixilation
