



Dear Spelling Bee Coordinator,

The 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Eastern Oklahoma State Spelling Bee will take place Friday, April 9th at the Muskogee Civic Center (425 Boston Street). Registration starts at 4:30 P.M. with the competition beginning at 6:30 P.M. Depending on Covid-19 we may not be able to have a full food court at our state bee event this year. We will have a hospitality area if we do not get to have our usual large hospitality room. It will open at 4:30 P.M. with soft drinks or water plus a few packaged snacks for all our contestants, family members, and special guests to enjoy.

Prizes will include engraved medals for each contestant, 2020 commemorative t-shirts, and trophies for first, second, and third place winners. We are excited to announce that the champion of the Eastern Oklahoma State Spelling Bee will receive a \$1,000.00 for his or her school and a \$500.00 cash prize. Our second place student will receive \$500.00 for his or her school and a \$250.00 cash prize. Third place student will receive \$250.00 for their school and \$100.00 cash prize. We are thrilled to offer these fantastic prizes for your school and students. The grand prize for our first place winner will be two tickets to a basketball game for the Oklahoma City Thunder. Games are played at the Chesapeake Energy Arena in OKC. Transportation is not provided to the game. Due to Covid -19 the grand prize may not be available this year. In regards of the tickets to the Thunder we must be cautious and will monitor things as we move closer to our event.

All student contestants will have the opportunity to win watches, tablets, headphones, gift baskets, and other fantastic prizes during the intermissions. These prizes will be given away by random drawings to students participating in the BEE. Thank you to our generous sponsors for making this occasion possible for our student contestants. We encourage all student contestants to stay in the arena until all the drawings have taken place.

Where there is a "two" listed by the bold items above, please give one to each of your student representatives. Let the student contestants know they must register at the state spelling bee competition with a parent, guardian, or a teacher who understands the spelling bee rules.

\*Take notice of the deadlines regarding champion and runner-up registration form and participation in the art contest. Deadlines are subject to extensions because of possible inclement weather conditions or Covid -19.

This year we are requesting that you have a third or fourth place student attend in the absence of your champion or runner-up. Please provide these students with the same word list by origins and

countries as your champion and runner-up. They will also need the spelling bee rules that can be located on our website. Some schools had no student representatives present on the stage last year. By providing this opportunity we believe each school should or will have representation at the state spelling bee event. The third or fourth place students will only participate if one of your winning students is not able to compete in Muskogee on Friday, April 3rd.

Please let us know if you are not able to open a particular form or other needed information on our website. I will be glad to send you the requested information separately by an email attachment directly to you. Just let me know and I will get that out to you very quickly.
