Make deposits by taking a picture with your phone! Remote Deposit Capture, available through our Mobile Banking app, lets you make deposits on your schedule from your location.

Exciting News - Debit Cards and Credit Cards Go "Real-Time"

To better serve our members, debit and credit cards go "real time" on October 25, 2017! This means that deposits made to an account are immediately available for use through the card; no more having to wait for an upload.

This also means that debit and credit charges against the balance are also reflected in the available balance immediately. Depending on how the charge is processed, it may post or show as "pending." For increased security and quicker posting of Debit Card transactions, we suggest choosing "Debit" (which requires the use of your PIN) over "Credit" for processing, when you are offered a choice. It's always a good idea to closely monitor your accounts, using our MagicLine, CU Online, Mobile services and Account Alerts.

Want us to let you know when your balance is getting low? Use Account Alerts in CU Online to send a text alert to yourself, telling you what you want to know, when you want to know it!
