Weekly Activity against Contract: 2014/15



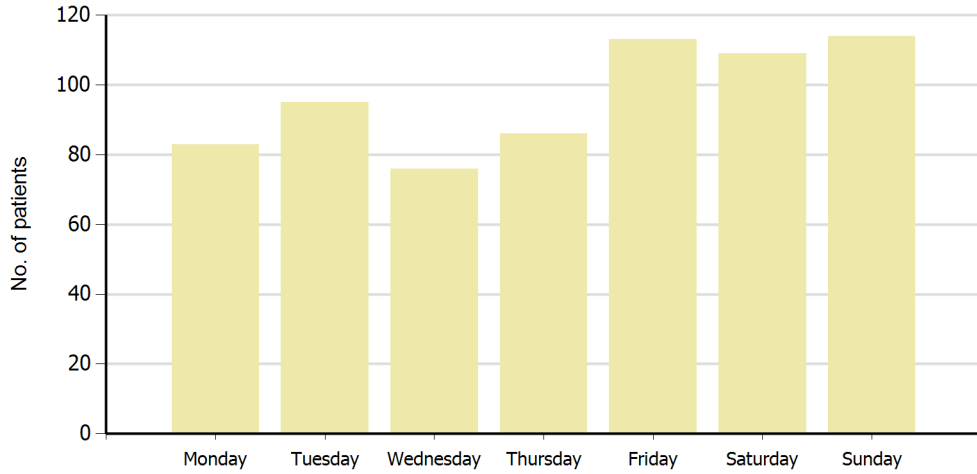

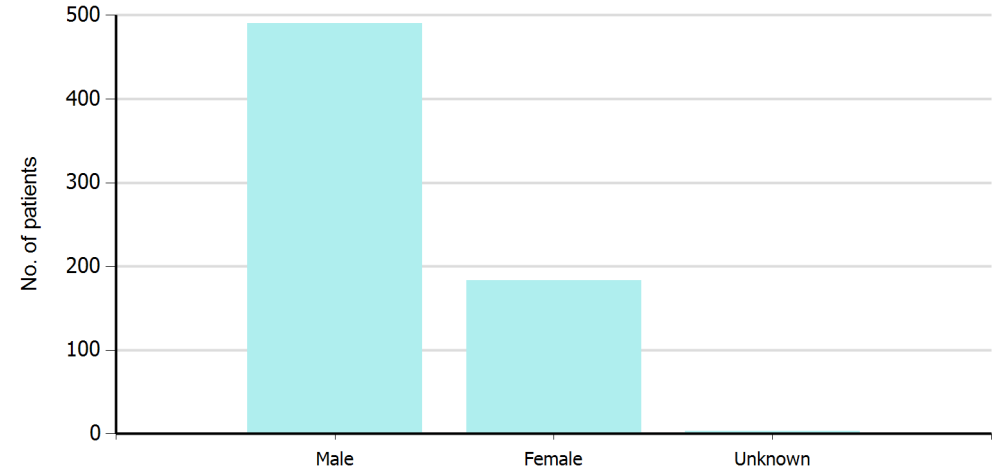

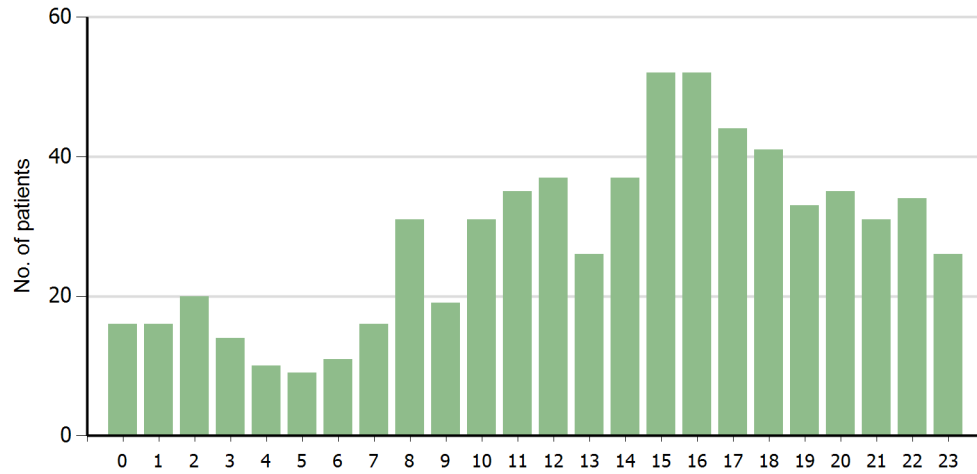
Activity (total) by Day of Week



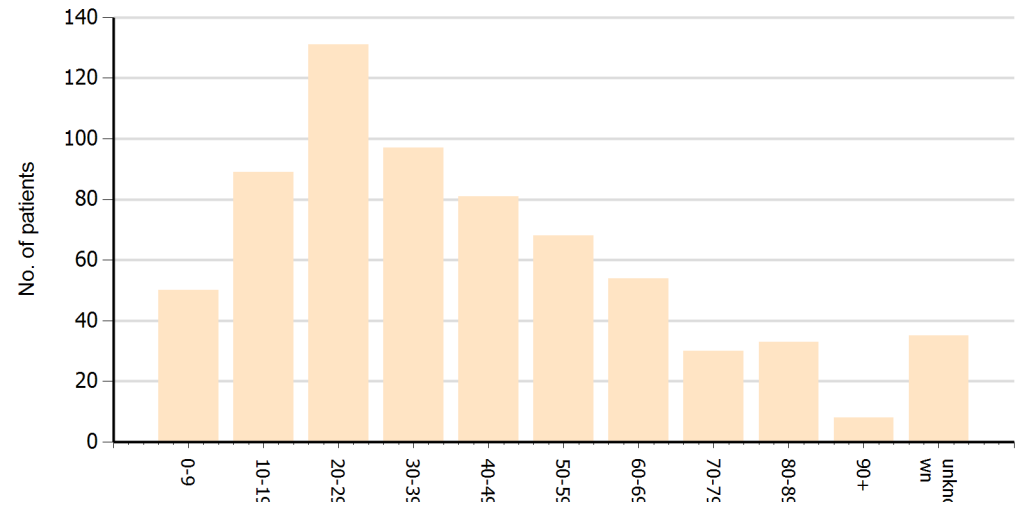
Activity (total) by Patient's Gender



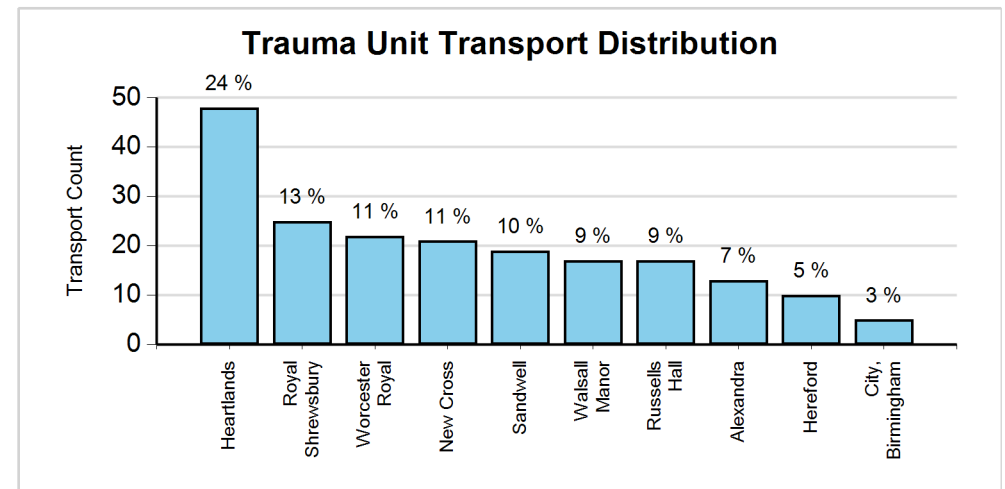
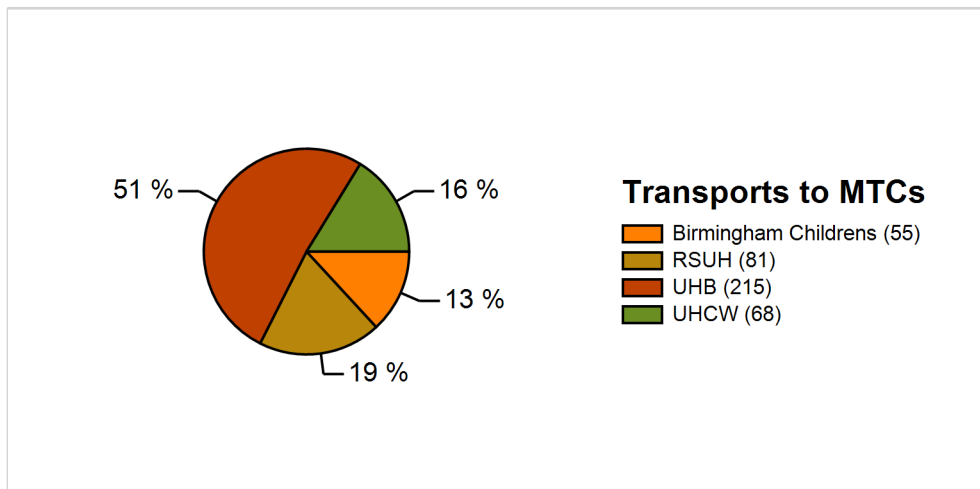
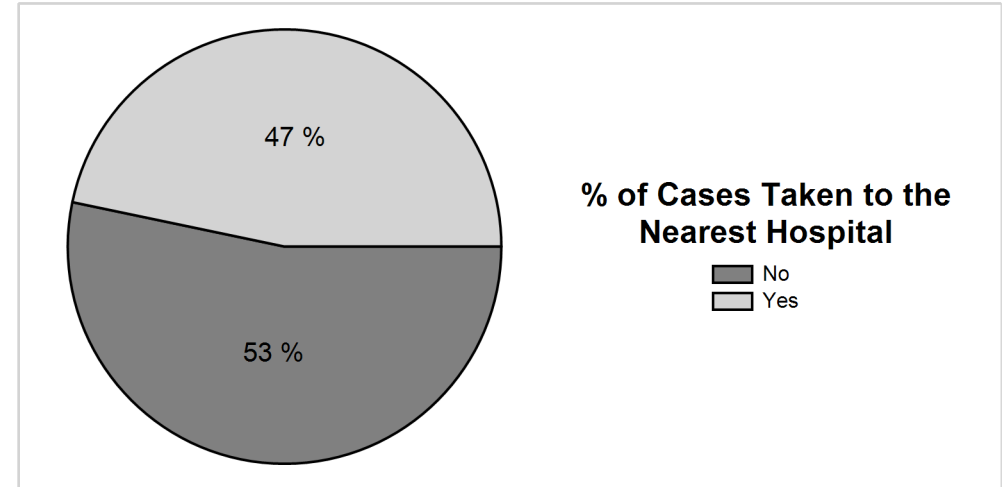
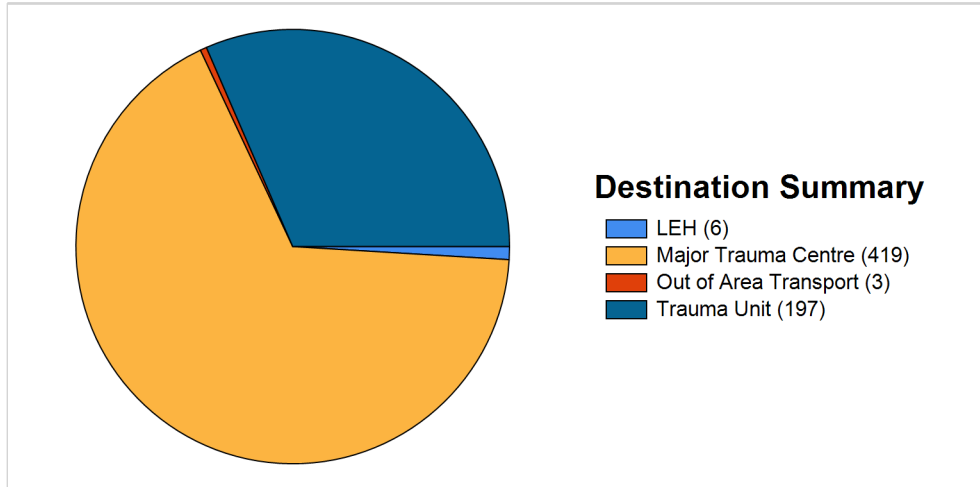
Activity (total) by Hour of Day

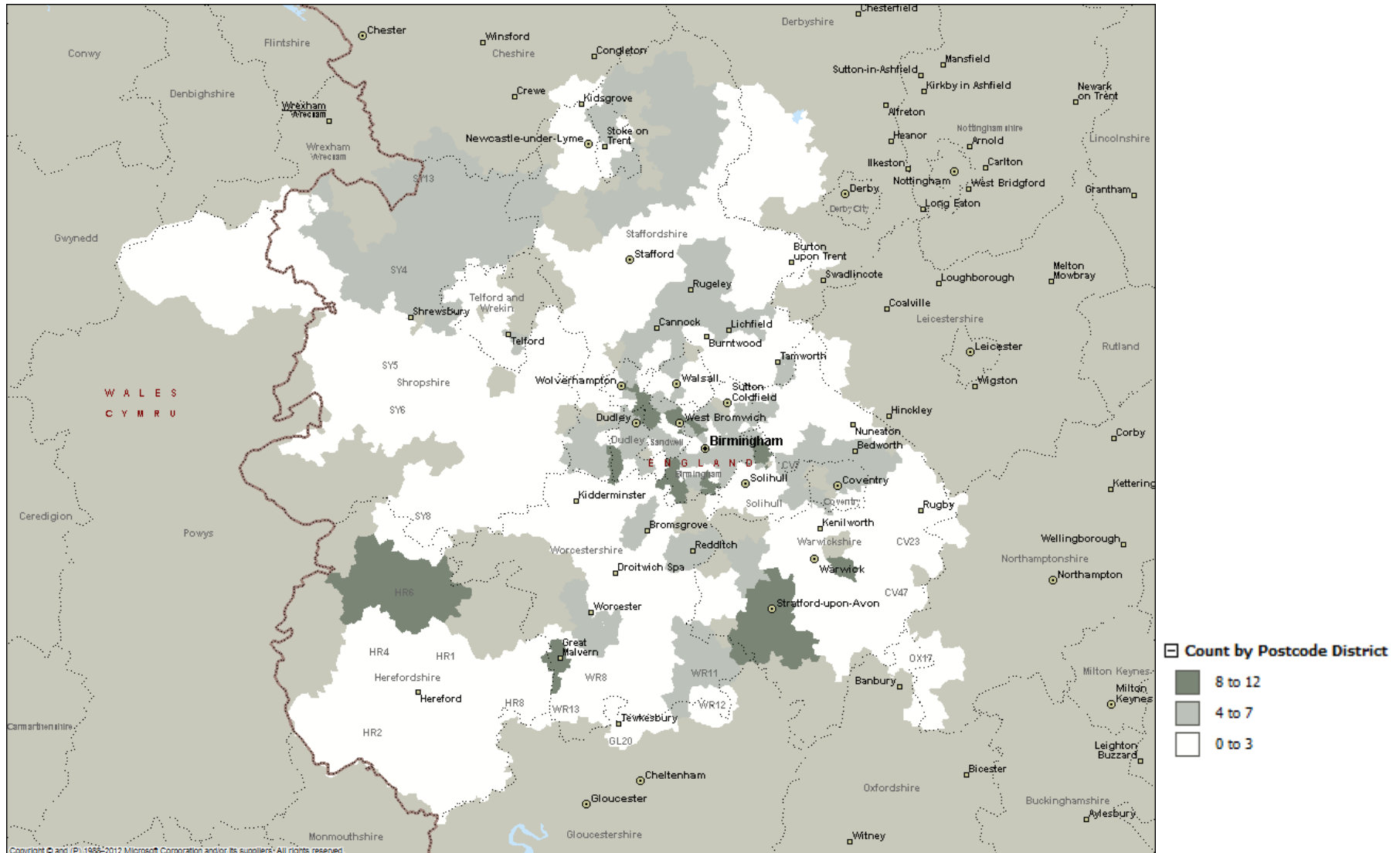

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Major Trauma Activity by Postcode Area

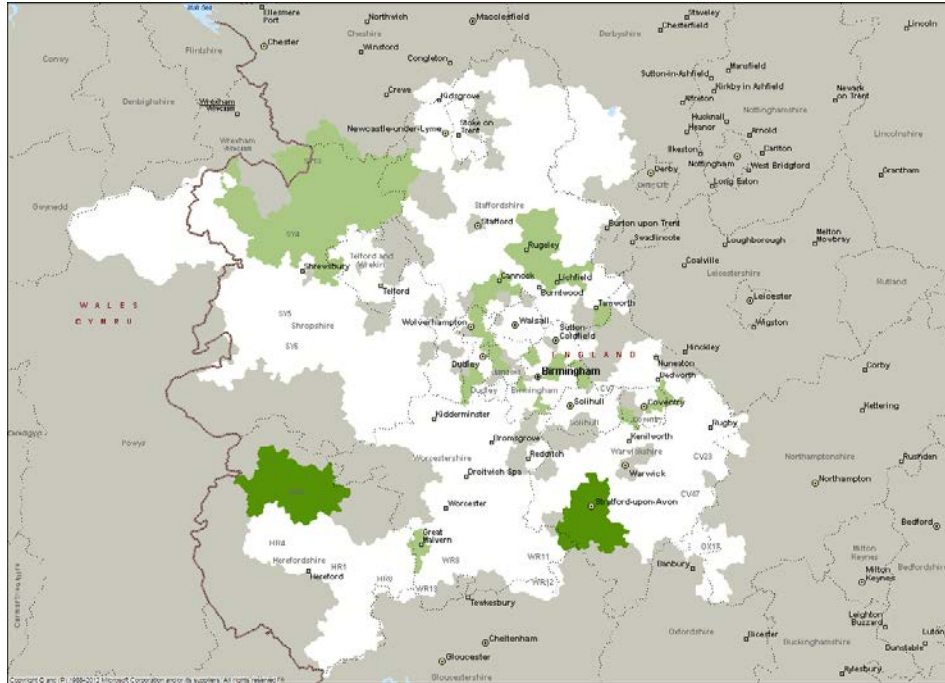

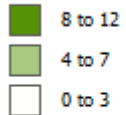
Major Trauma Activity by Postcode Area and Shift

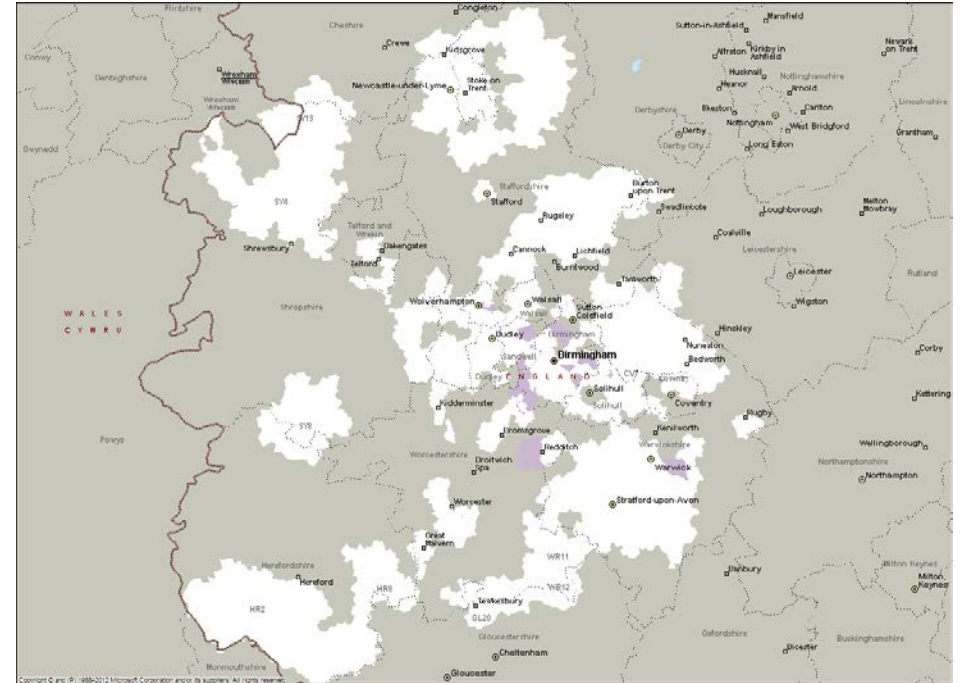

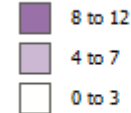
Count by Postcode District



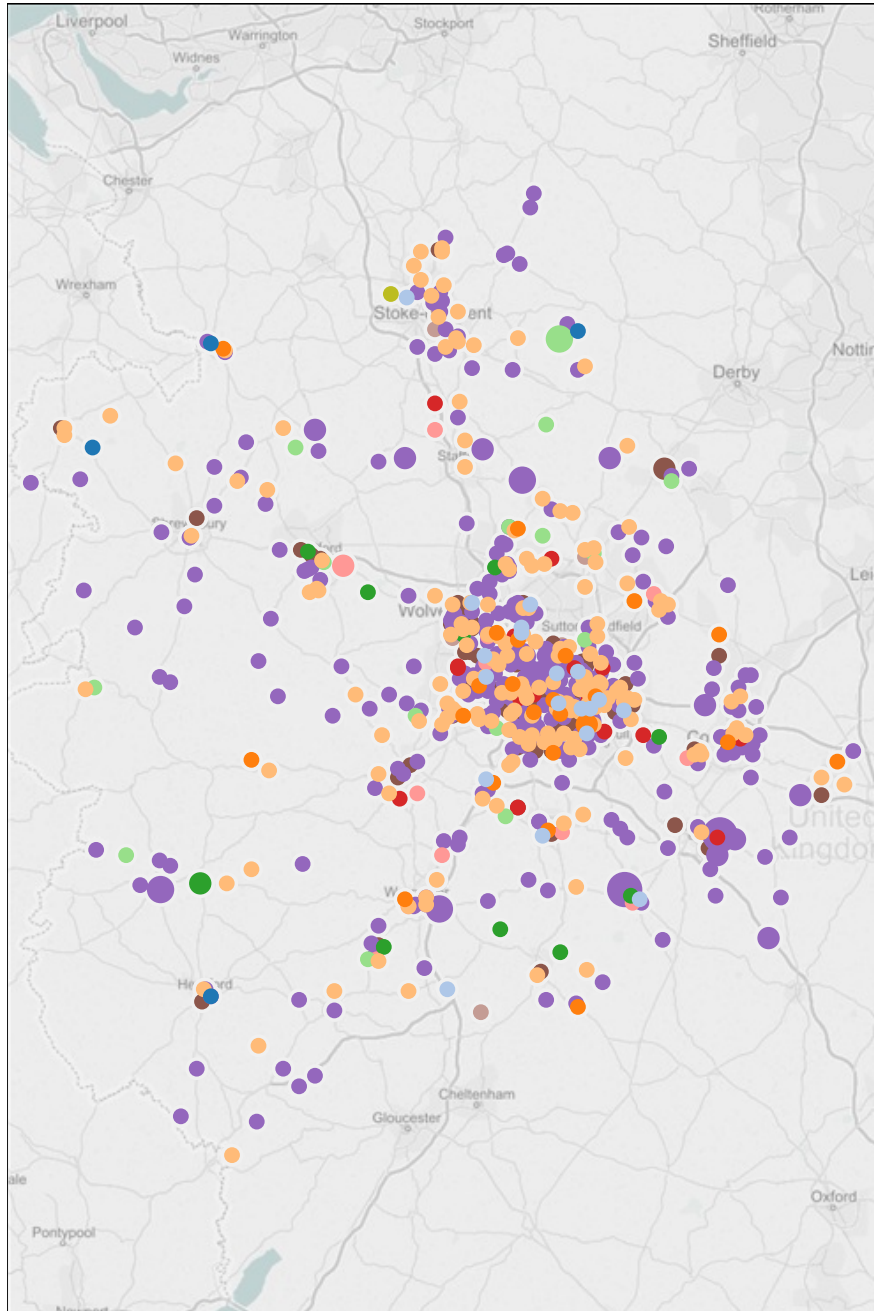

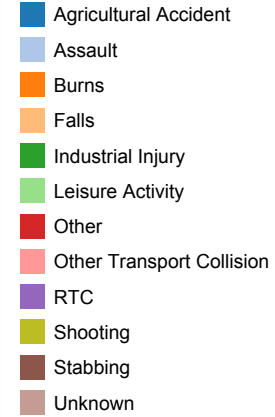
Incident Location of Major Trauma Patients by Type of Incident 2015/16



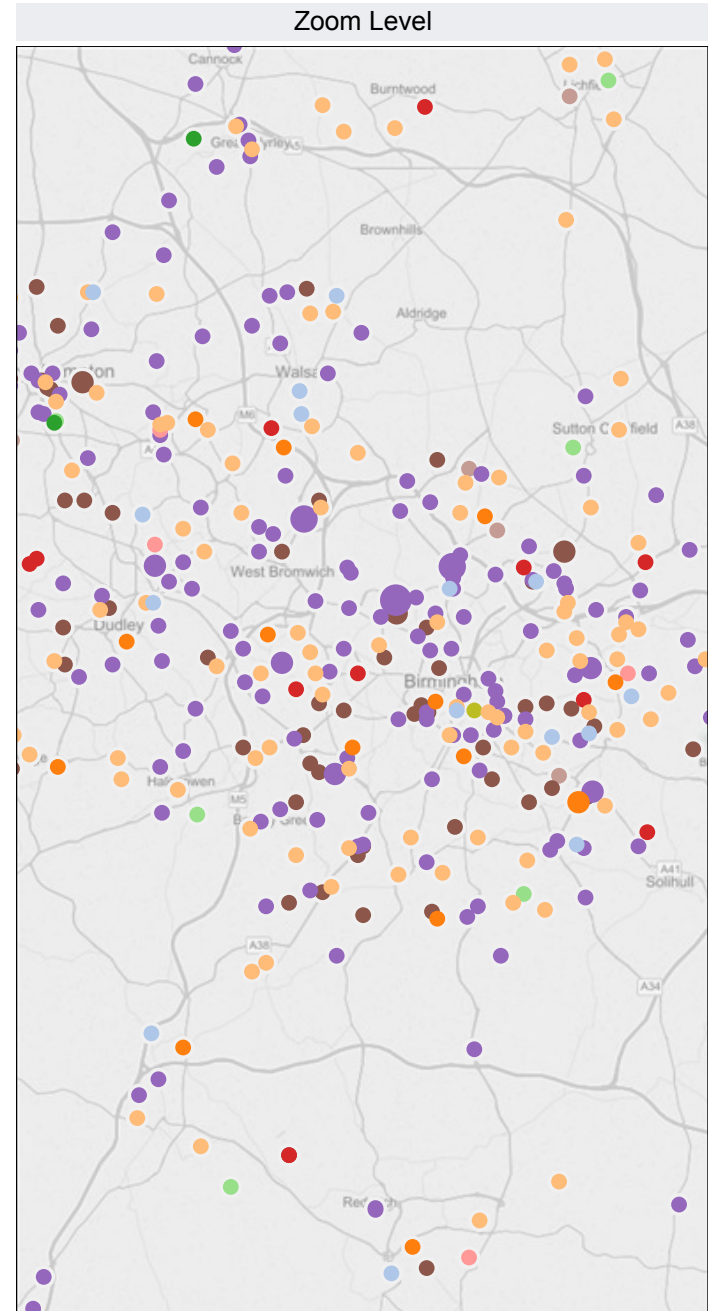

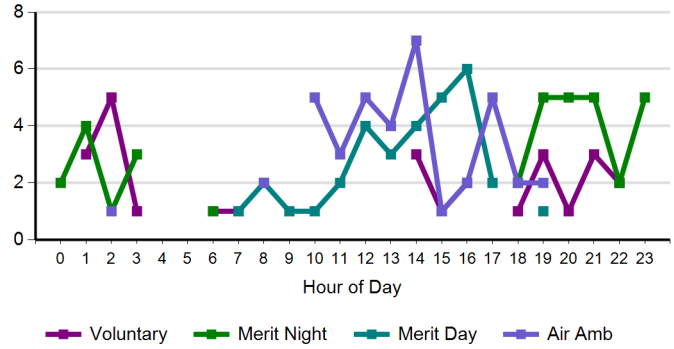




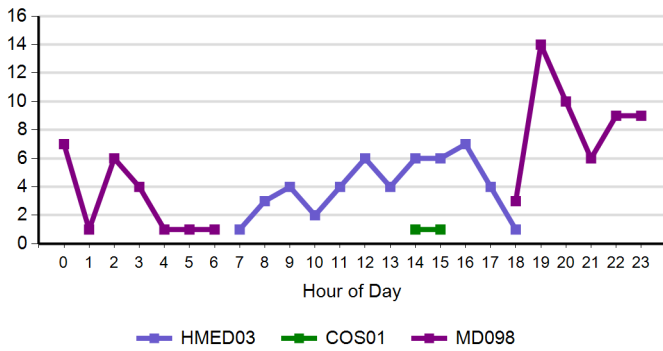
All Cases Attended - By Group



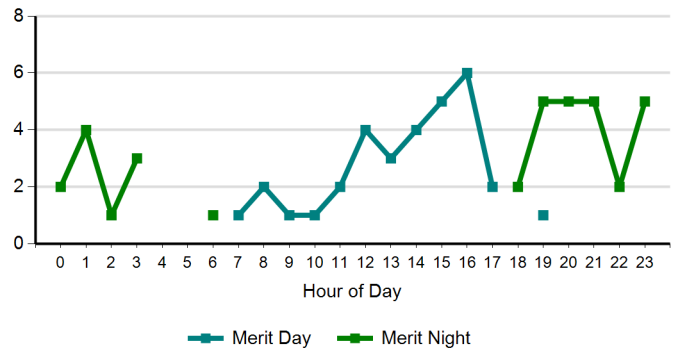
Trauma Cases Attended - By Group



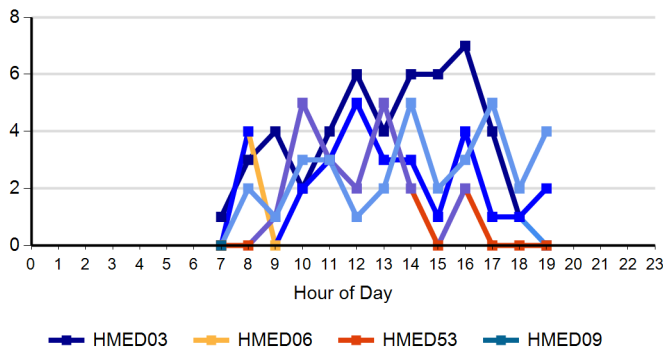
All Cases Attended by MERIT



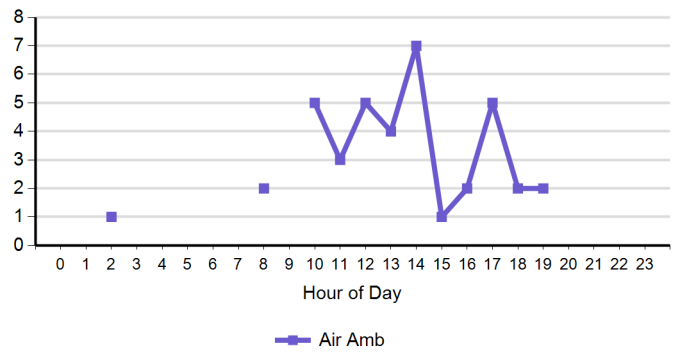

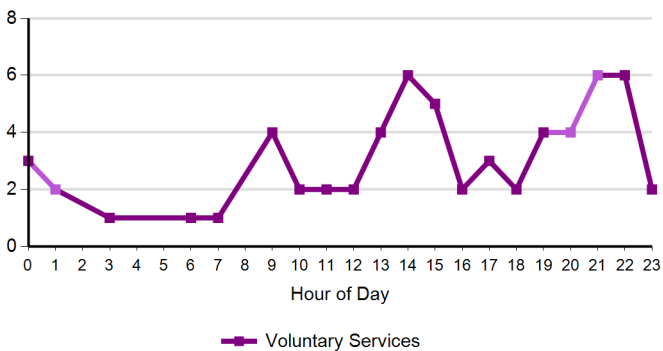
All Cases Attended by Air Ambulance



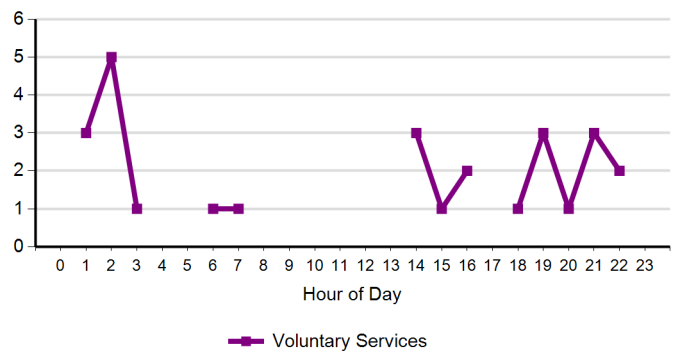

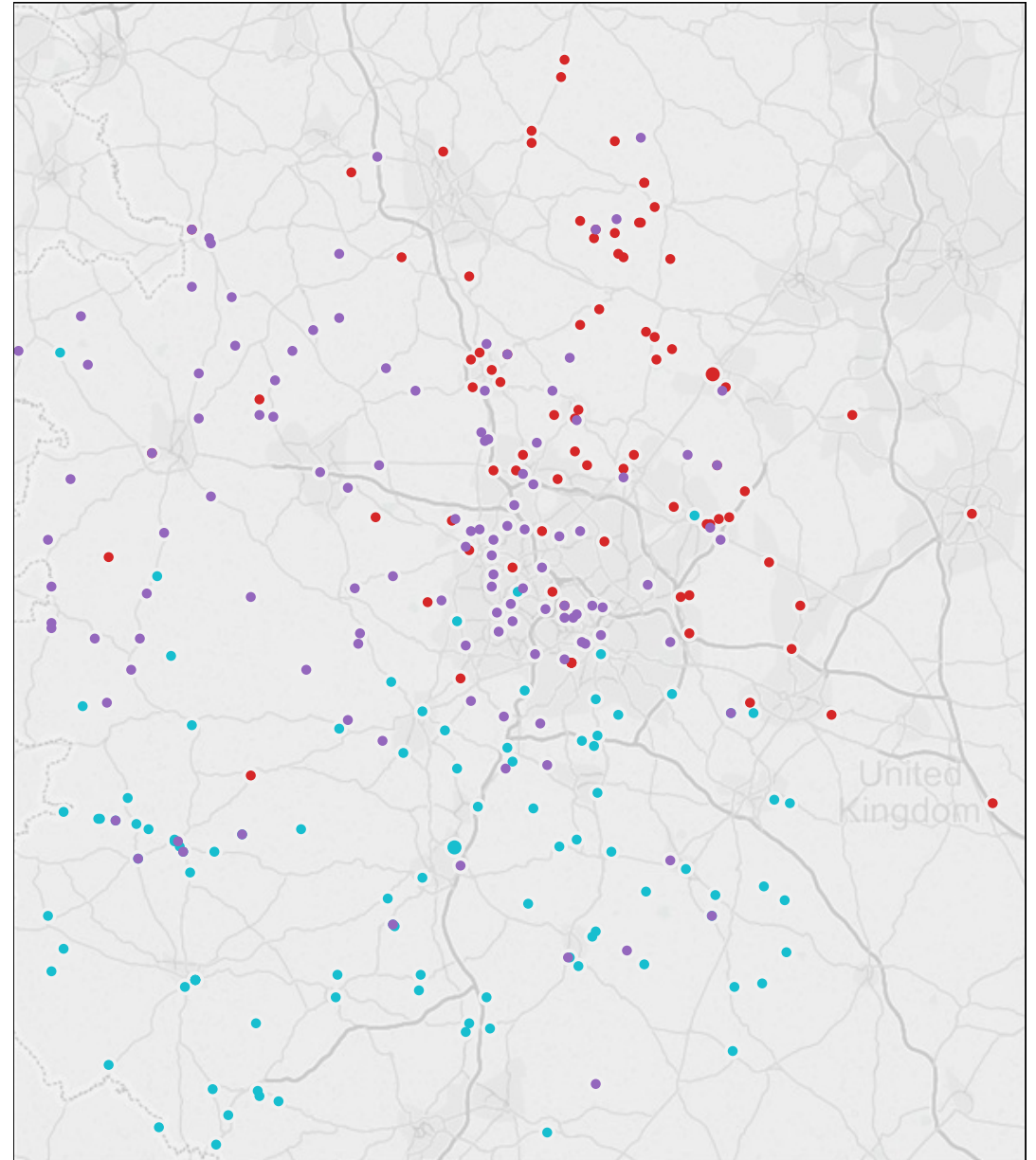
