

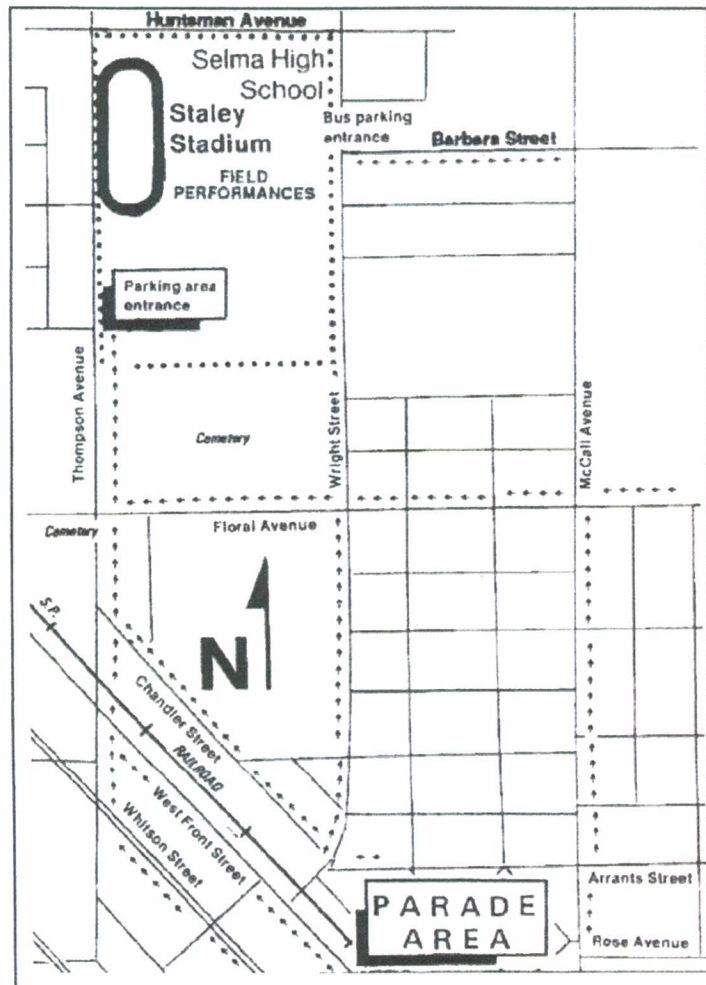
How To Reach Selma High and Staley Stadium

Selma High School's Staley Stadium, home of the Bears, is where today's field show competition will take place. It's easy to find. Use this map, with the streets leading to the stadium marked with arrows.

Your best bet is to approach the stadium, located on the west side of the Selma High campus, by using Thompson Avenue. The campus is three-quarters of a mile north of the downtown parade route. Take either Whitson Street (old Highway 99), West Front Street or Chandler Street northeasterly (paralleling the railroad) from downtown to Thompson Avenue, and then turn north. You'll pass two cemeteries, the City of Selma's W.H. Shafer Park and the J. Frank Parks Education Center before reaching the stadium parking area. All no parking zones are strictly enforced. No wrong-way parking or double parking is permitted on Selma streets.

If you're not going to the stadium, you'll find a fall festival of fun in downtown Selma's Lincoln Park, at the end of the parade route. Many community organizations are sponsoring food and game booths. All Selma stores are open.
