Angela Fauri Lynch, 98, of Bad Axe died Tuesday, June 25, 2002, at home. She was born April 1, 1904 in Mansfield Township in Iron County. She was the daughter of the late Joseph and Angela Fauri. She attended the Mansfield School and graduated from Crystal Falls High School in 1921. She earned her bachelor of science degree from Western State University and her masters degree in library science from the University of Michigan. She taught in Republic, Ironwood, Crystal Falls, Port Austin, Bad Axe and Harbor Beach. She retired in 1969. Her career in education spanned 42 years. Miss Angela Fauri married Richard W. Lynch on Aug. 5, 1929 in Crystal Falls. He preceded her in death on Nov. 6, 1978. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church of Bad Axe, the American Association of University Women, and the Michigan Education Association. She enjoyed reading, was an avid bridge player, and was well traveled. Mrs. Lynch is survived by her two sons, Richard F. Lynch and his wife, Rosilind, of Spring Lake and Patrick J. Lynch and his wife, Patricia, of Columbia, Md.; one granddaughter, Judith Ann of Muskegon; two grandsons, Michael R. and his wife, Tracey, and Michael P. and his wife, Toni; great-grandchild Michael; and several nieces and nephews. Preceding her in death was a son, John F. Lynch; sister Lodovine Fauri Burling; four sisters and two brothers.
