### **DCR Transmission, L.L.C. (Ten West Link Project) Approved for Certificate of Environmental Compatibility**

The Arizona Corporation Commission approved an application in conformance with the requirements of A.R.S. § 40-360 et. seq., for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (CEC) authorizing the 500-kilovolt transmission line, which includes the construction of a new 125-mile kilovolt transmission line between Arizona Public Service Company's Delaney Substation and Southern California Edison's Colorado River Substation, to be referred to as the Ten West Link Project.

The project will enhance reliability and capacity between California and Arizona and will provide greater access to the California energy market and its increasing supply of low cost and sometimes negatively priced energy.

The project will have minimal effects on the environment and ecology of the state. DCR Transmission will work with the town of Quartzsite, AZ during construction to maximize job opportunities and tax revenue, in return, bringing economic benefits to the state. The project is expected to be completed by the end of 2021.
