BOOKING YOUR HUNT

- Booking begins each year on January 1st
- Deposits are 50 % of the cost of a hunt and are due(at time) of booking
- Final payment is due (30 days) prior to hunt date
- Hunting reservations are not complete until we receive a completed and signed Hunting Agreement, Release and Indemnification form along with your deposit
- Prices are per hunt per year
- Hunter is responsible for purchasing all tags and responsible for purchasing the correct tags for the area and species they are hunting
- Tags, food, ATV'S, hunting equipment, lodging are not provided
- Deposits are non-refundable. In the event that a client does not draw a tag a refund will be given within 30 days of proof that the client did not draw.
- All major credit cards and certified checks are accepted

TRIP PLANNING

- Transportation, lodging, meals, clothing and ATV's are not provided
- Hunters need to provide their own transportation to and from hunting site
- Hunters are responsible for his/her own hunting equipment and ATV's
- Hooker Mountain will assist you with field dressing your animal, all edible portions of game shall be taken, hunters are responsible for meat, cape and antlers and transporting animal for processing

FIREARM SAFETY POLICY

The following safety rules for handling firearms shall be adhered to at all times.

- Keep all firearms unloaded until you reach the hunting area or until instructed by your guide to load your magazine. Unload all firearms at the end of the day before heading back to camp. Firearms are to remain unloaded while in camp.
- Do not chamber a bullet until directed to do so by your guide, only chamber a round when preparing to shoot an animal.
- Muzzle control is expected from each hunter at all times. Never point your firearm at anything you do not intend to shoot.
- Always open your bolt to be sure your chamber is empty before putting your gun in a vehicle.
- Firearms shall be carried in the vehicle muzzle down at all times.

Failure to adhere to these safety rules will result in having your hunt terminated. Should your hunt be terminated from failure to follow safe gun handling practices no refunds will be awarded.

ALCOHOL POLICY: No alcohol and/or drugs shall be consumed during the days hunt, until all firearms associated with the hunt are unloaded and stored for the day. Detection of alcohol and/or drug use while in the field will be considered grounds for immediate dismissal from the hunt. This determination can be made at the sole discretion of Hooker Mountain Outfitters and/or its guides.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need a hunter safety card?

Hunters born after January 1st, 1949 are required to have in possession a hunter's safety card

What does semi-guided mean?

A semi-guided hunt for us means that every day the outfitter (or a guide) will accompany you to the spot that will give you the best opportunity to kill, offer insight into the general game movement patterns for that area, and the smartest routes.

Do you offer drop camps? We do not offer drop camps

Do you have vouchers? We do have vouchers for deer and Antelope (very limited)

Do you offer a discount for combination hunt? We offer a 500.00 discount for elk & deer combo hunts

Can I pay online? Yes! After we receive your hunting request and availability is confirmed, we will send you an email with your booking agreement, waiver and online payment instructions via DocuSign. A final payment request is sent out about 30 days prior to your hunt date via email invoice with online payment option.

Gratuity (tipping my guide) A common question we are asked by many clients is what about gratuity or "tipping my guide" and how much? In support of this, we explain to hunters that they are in the care of experienced guides whose skill and knowledge will most likely determine the success of their hunt. While tips are absolutely not mandatory, they are always appreciated and without a doubt, well earned. In most service industries it is customary up to tip 10 percent.
