As I begin I want to first thank the Lord Jesus Christ for placing us in each other's lives. I'm thankful for everything your ministry is doing in service to our King Jesus. You have been the same faithful brother since I first met you at Red Rock.

For me, I'm still 'Fired Up and Flying High!' There is nothing on this planet or any other planet that can quench the Fire that God Almighty has put in my spirit, soul and bones! I don't care how bad it may look on the outside I know there's a greater report. The report of Jesus, the Christ, who is the Word! With 7,487 promises in His Word, that is over 20 promises per day for every single day of the year!

I refuse to get discouraged; I refuse to hang my head. I refuse to walk in defeat when Jesus has already won the victory on the Cross of Calvary. Since when has Calvary NOT been enough for me or for anybody else, especially believers!? It's time for the brother's and sister's to mount up in victory. Pray from victory, NOT for victory! Holy Spirit has really been ministering to me about 'man'. The problem in the body of Christ and in the world is, 'man' doesn't know who they really are in Christ Jesus. The spirit man is still dead, it needs to be awaken! Man is still running around like a blind dog in a meat house, he doesn't know who he is.

So the question I ask everyone is this, "Is your spirit man alive?" This word is for the brother's and sister's who are struggling behind the walls AND for those who are free physically but in bondage spiritually.

It's time for man and woman to realize who they are in Jesus the Christ. When you realize who you are in Jesus Christ it doesn't matter where you are on this earth. You could be in the deepest darkest hole on the earth and still know in your soul (mind, will and emotions) who you are. That is the spirit man's job. The soul identifies with the world system, your flesh and these five senses; what you hear, see, taste, smell and touch. Your spirit identifies with the Word of God. That 'Man' within us is perfect. Jesus, the Christ's job is to make us perfect in order to present us to the Father. Jesus the Christ is the greatest bounty hunter ever, sent directly from heaven. He found sin! He destroyed it all on the Cross of Calvary. Then He exposed satan by disarming him and making a public spectacle of him and his minions, triumphing over them. Look here in Colossians 2:13-15, "When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross. And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross."

Jesus the Christ is the greatest business man ever, at 12 years old He told His parents, "Willy ware you scarching for Ma?" He asked. "Didn't you know I had to be in My Father's house?" (Luke 2:49) And the very next verse, Luke 2:50 it's recorded, "But they did not understand what he was saying to them." And we as the body of Christ still don't understand that the currency of heaven is our faith in God's Word! A lot of times we try to forgive ourselves but it wasn't us that went to the Cross! Jesus the Christ is the ONLY Man who can forgive our sin. The Word tells us, in Romans 10:9-10, "If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved."

So it's finished, done right then and there! It's the liar, satan, that uses our thoughts to move our flesh, either for good or bad. Here's a simple example. When you have to go to the bathroom a thought enters your head and tells your flesh to get up and go. If you don't act on that thought you may soon realize that that warm sensation running down your leg was, well, you know, you wet yourself.

Brothers and sisters the devil will come at you hard from time to time accusing you of not being saved based on your action. IT'S A LIE! Then he will come trying to accuse you of, "Not being worth anything but a no good convict, the black sheep of your family." It's ALL a lie from the pits of hell! Listen here for a minute. Jesus has a fivefold ministry that He is exercising at the throne of God, on our behalf.

1) He is our High priest, "Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, whom we acknowledge as our apostle and high priest ... Therefore He is able to save completely those who come to God through Him, because He always lives to intercede for them." (Hebrews 3:1, 7:25)

 He is our Mediator, "For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all people. This has now been witnessed to at the proper time." (1 Timothy 2:5-6)

3) He is our Advocate, "My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have an advocate with the Father—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One." (1 John 2:1)

4) He is our security, "Because of this oath, Jesus has become the guarantor of a better covenant." (Hebrews 7:22)

5) And He is our Intercessor, "Therefore He is able to save completely those who come to God through Him, because He always lives to intercede for them." (Hebrews 7:25)

Man is a spirit made in the likeness of the God head - in the likeness of God. "So God created mankind in His own image, in the image of God He created them; male and female He created them." (Genesis 1:27) Man is the highest form of creation. That's exactly why satan is so mad, because God made 'man' in His likeness and similitude. Man is not of this earth. Earth is not in the likeness and image of God. Man IS the greatest of ALL creation! God put an ability in man and man must respond to that ability to be responsible. Spirit Man is the only thing that is perfect. "However, as it is written: 'What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived' — the things God has prepared for those who love Him — these are the things God has revealed to us by His Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. For who knows a person's thoughts except their own spirit within them? In the same way no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us. This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words. The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit. The person with the Spirit makes judgments about all things, but such a person is not subject to merely human judgments, for, 'Who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct Him?' But we have the mind of Christ." (1 Corinthians 2:9-16)

If man doesn't know who he is, he surely doesn't know who woman is. What is woman? Woman is the glory of man, his praise, honor, the splendor of life that God could bring forth from a man. Look at these Scriptures that witness to these statements I've made. "The LORD God said, 'It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him' ... So the LORD God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep; and while he was sleeping, He took one of the man's ribs and then closed up the place with flesh. Then the LORD God made a woman from the rib He had taken out of the man, and He brought her to the man. The man said, 'This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called 'woman,' for she was taken out of man.' That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh." (Genesis 2:18, 21-24)

Now, 1 Corinthians 11:7-9, "A man ought not to cover his head, since he is the image and glory of God; but woman is the glory of man. For man did not come from woman, but woman from man; neither was man created for woman, but woman for man." She will bring forth the very likeness and image of our flesh. Brother's, we become a father to our child the minute it's conceived. There was no way that Adam could deny Seth as his son. Why? Because sin had come in the flesh to bring man back into the likeness of God.

So, I chose to violate and petitioned my PO, judge and attorney to release me after the 90 day violation into long-term Christian program. With three years of parole to do, no family in California to reside with, I needed half-way housing to get off the streets. Please pray for me, that this is God's will ... **R.E.D.** 

I have a friend for whom I'm requesting prayer. We will call him 'Nick' and he is a slave to tobacco and I have encouraged him to pray for the strength to quit. Would you all join me in praying for him to realize how happy he can be emancipated from the detrimental addiction like nicotine? Addiction is a bad, bad thing! But through it all I always turned back to God and Jesus. Then God said "Enough!" and moved me to a lower custody yard. Praise God! When I got

here to this medium yard there were a lot of Christian brothers here. We hold church 3 times a week plus volunteers come on Mondays. So our services are Wednesday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday. In it I'm learning more and more about my Lord and Savior. God asked me one morning when I was doing my studies and praying, "What did you learn from your experience at the other yard?" So I stopped and thought about what I didn't have or do and instead what I do have and use every day, and four days a week, help from the church and drug programs. I can't do this by myself. As a consequence, according to God's Word, many of them and their children died in the wilderness because they would not submit to God's ways. Their children were affected by their decisions. And so are ours.

Today, my oldest son rarely even wants to speak to me. He's always busy or whatever because he doesn't know what to say to me due to the fact that I've let him and his brother down time and time again, always disappointing them and returning to prison. God has made me aware of how my sons have suffered greatly from my own disobedience. And it's because of that I realize the importance of my obedience today. And through my obedience, restoration is available. Our decisions to obey God affect other people, and when we decide to obey God, that affects other people too. You may choose to disobey God and stay in the wilderness, but PLEASE keep in mind, if you have children or ever will have children, your decisions will keep them in the wilderness with you. They may manage to get themselves out when they are grown, but I can assure you that they will pay a price for your disobedience. Obedience is a far-reaching choice; It closes the gates of hell and opens the windows of heaven, and it has the power to affect many people. Just think of it: Because of Jesus' willingness to be obedient, countless multitudes will be brought into right standing with God.

Your very life may be in better shape today had someone in your past obeyed God. If there is a cycle of disobedience in your family or among your friends, why not break it by refusing to be disobedient in YOUR life? Tell God that you want to obey and ask Him to help you overcome your disobedience. That way, you will set yourself up along with your children for great blessings.

#### I Thank Christ Jesus By G.H.

From Ephesus, Paul wrote to the Corinthians, in 1 Corinthians 16:9,"For a great and effective door has opened to me, and there are many adversaries." And yet again, Paul writes in 1 Timothy 1:12, 16, "And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord who has enabled me, because He counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry ... I pray we will find men and women of faith.

#### New Things On the Rise By B.M.

#### Isaiah 41:5-42:25

One day God will gather all of His faithful people and we should not fear because God is with us, God has built a relationship with us and God gives us the guarantee of His strength over death and sin. Take time to consider all of the ways in which God has helped you this far. (41:8-10)

When you feel broken and burned out God won't step on you and push you aside as being worthless. Instead, He will gently pick you up. Through God's Spirit, we can show this kind of sensitivity to the people around us who may be suffering. (42:1-4)

Look at all the amazing things God will not only do for us but also do through us. Let your praise to God show how you truly feel. (42:10)

Sometimes partial blindness, seeing but not understanding or knowing what is right, but blowing it off instead of doing it is even worse than being completely blind. (42:19-20)

#### Ephesians 2:1-3:7

Satan is only temporary ruler of the part of the world that has chosen to follow him. It is our Lord Jesus Christ who is permanent Ruler of the whole world. (2:2)

Because of the resurrection of Christ, we know that we too shall be raised from the dead. (1 Corinthians 15:2-23) We've been given power to live right now as Christians. (2:6)

We should always respond with gratitude and praise for our salvation and faith. (2:8-9)

When Paul started sharing the Good News, God gave him the ability to speak very well. You are probably not a minister, apostle or evangelist but God will put opportunities before you to tell people about Jesus Christ and along with those opportunities God will provide the strength and courage to do so. (3:7)

#### Psalm 67:1-7

This Psalm speaks of the fulfillment of God's great commission, when Jesus said to take the gospel to all nations. (*Matthew 28:18-20*) We need to count ourselves as a part of the great cloud of believers who know Jesus Christ, glorify Him for the Good News and continue to share His gospel so that the harvest will continue to grow in abundance. (67:2)

## Proverbs 24:9-10

#### Who Do People Say That I Am? By W.R.

People wear masks and often present themselves in a manner other than what they are.

Believe me, satan himself masquerades as an angel of light, as seen here in 2 Corinthians 11:14, "But I am not surprised! Even satan disguises himself as an angel of light." Judas was chosen by Jesus to be one of His disciples but the Scriptures tell us, in John 6:70, Jesus asked, "Dit I not always you, the twelve, and and of you is a doub?" The same man, in Matthew 26:15, betrayed Jesus asking, "What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?' And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver." Do you know the interesting thing about that exchange? In the Bible, silver color means truth. We as Christians betray Jesus every time we sin, and for a lot less than 30 pieces of silver! In most cases we do so for our own selfish needs and desires.

Who do people say that you are? We can call ourselves Christians, we can call ourselves anything but who we really are, can and will be seen by the fruit that we bear. Jesus gave us a measuring stick in which to identify His followers when He said, in *Matthew 7:15-20*, "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in alteap's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous welves. You will know them by their truths. Do man gather grapes from thembushes or itys from thistles? Even so, every good tree bears good that, but a bad tree bears had that. A good tree cannot bear bed truth, nor can a bad tree bear good that. Every tree that does not bear good that is cut down and thrown into the firs. Therefore by their thats you will know them." Jesus took it even a little further in *Luke 11:23*, when He said, "We who is not with life is against life, and he who does not gather with life scatters." And His words are translated like this, "This is a war, and whoever is not on my slife is against life, and whoever does not gather the spalls with life will be forever scattered." in the Passion Translation. So it's obvious that Jesus drew the line in the sand over 2000 years ago. Either we are with Him, bearing and gathering good fruit, or we are against Him. There's no middle ground here, there's no straddling the fence either. You read it, Jesus has left no doors open for compromising 'The Truth'.

In God's Word it tells us that we are either the children of God OR we are the children of the devil. Now let's read 1 John 3:8-10, "He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. Whoever has been born of God does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God." And we've already seen above that Jesus made it clear to us that, "by their that your will know that." So the question remains, "Who are you?" But now I find myself posing that same question to myself, "Who am I?" And, "Who do people say that I am?"

In Matthew 16:13-14, when Jesus asked His disciples, "Whe de people say the Sen of Man is?" They replied, 'Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets." But then Jesus turned and asked Peter this very same question in Matthew 16:15, "But whe do you say that I am?" Verse 16 shows us, "Simon Peter answered and said, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." The religious leaders rejected that truth and were even offended by it and the people asked, in Mark 6:3, "Isn't this the carpenter? Isn't this Mary's son and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas and Simon? Aren't His sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him." And then in John 1:46, Nathaniel posed this question, "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" With this statement from Nathaniel I would assume that Nazareth must have been a pretty bad neighborhood and that being a carpenter was not a very prestigious occupation.

It's obvious that the religious leaders and the people were making certain assumptions while coming to certain conclusions in lieu of Jesus' background. And all of us are or have been guilty of that same point in our own lives. We all form opinions and predigests towards others before we even know them or have anything concrete in which to base our opinions upon!

Nathaniel had already formulated an opinion about Nazareth and the people living there before he had even met Jesus. We see this in his questioning, "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?"

Now I would like to personalize this question and take it to another level by asking you, "Could anything good come from the East/West side of Dayton? Can anything come out of a drug/crime infested neighborhood? Can anything good come out of a prison?" I've known some pretty shady characters throughout the 48 years that I've been in prison. AND I've read about some pretty shady people in the Bible, who by all means should have been in prison. Take for instance Moses, David and the Apostle Paul. They were all murderers. Absalom, King David's son, killed his own brother Amnon for raping their own sister Tamar. (Read *Exodus 2:12, 2 Samuel 11:11-15, 2 Samuel 13:11,14, 32, Acts 7:58* and *Acts 8:1-3*) By the worlds standards they were all criminals and if they were alive today they would all be in prison or sitting in a cell on death row awaiting their execution!

In all probability the disciple Peter would have been in a cell with all of them for aggravated assault after cutting that guys ear off, "Then Simon Peter, who had a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's servant, cutting off his right ear.

(The servant's name was Malchus.)" (John 18:10), the night that Jesus was arrested. That incident would have gotten Peter a 10 year sentence today!

So the question remains, "Who do people say that I am?" And "Can anything good come out of prison?" If you were to pose that question to the people in society they would in all good conscious, and rightfully so, label me as a criminal, a murderer. And by the worlds standards they would be justified in coming to that conclusion. But God uses and has a different standard in His judgment. He looks beyond our social status and appearance and instead peers in to our hearts. The Word tells us in 1 John 3:15, "Anyone who hates a brother or sister is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life residing in him." And Jeremiah 17:9 reads, "The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?" When Nathaniel asked Philip, "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?" listen to Philips response, "Come and see!"

So again I pose the question to you, "Can anything good come out of prison?" And I would tell you, "Come and see the pierced hands of God that touches even the hardest of hearts, and watch them soften. I would ask you to come see the lepers of our society, who have been cleansed by a touch of the Master's hand. Those who have been set free from drug and alcohol addictions. I would ask you to come with me to the worst part of your city and see the pierced hands of God as they wipe away the tears from the prostitutes face and forgive another for the most reprehensible crimes that you could imagine." The hands that fashioned the stars and shaped the mountains are now molding and shaping all these lives into the treasured possessions that God has created them all to be. These same hands are reaching out to you today, beckoning you to come to the Cross to witness for yourselves the lives that have been changed by the touch of the Master's hand!

And now I would ask you to come with me to Death Row and witness for yourselves the joy radiating from the face of the man condemned to die, the one who has just received a pardon, not from the governor, but from the King of kings! Then I would ask you to come and see me. I would ask you to read my testimony and read my poetry in which I have bared my soul with pen and paper so that you could look into my heart. It's there that you would see the life changing power of God at work in my life! THEN, I would ask you, "Who do you say that I am?"
