Past Cardboard events made it possible for us to renovate the building, expand to serving each weeknight, pay off the building loan, add meal delivery for seniors who are shut-in, purchase a better van, and build a very needed parking lot.

Warm Blessings serves hot meal weeknights and offers showers, washer/dryer use to those who may be homeless or need these services. We usually serve 50 or more individuals, deliver meals on Monday and Thursday to approximately 35 seniors who are homebound, provide personal items and crisis food bags as needed, offer day shelter in the winter and serve as an afternoon relief center in warmer weather.

Your support is needed to help us continue to reach our most vulnerable citizens.

## Area Statistics

\*50% of the patrons served at the Warm Blessing report an income of less than \$7,000 per year

\* As many as 20% report being homeless in the past year.

\*May 2013 Hardin County Schools reported 53% of enrolled students qualifying for free or reduced lunch. This involves 7,675 students out of an enrollment of 14,483. Elizabethtown Independent schools reports 51% of the students are free lunch eligible.
