I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide safe transportation for students and to educate students on safety issues and the responsibilities of school bus ridership.

II. STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SAFETY TRAINING

It is the responsibility of NWSISD member school districts to provide school bus safety training to students participating in NWSISD programs, activities and magnet schools.

III. NWSISD TRANSPORTATION SAFETY DIRECTOR

The Executive Director or their designee will work with member districts' safety directors. The NWSISD designee will assure that this policy is reviewed annually to ensure that it conforms to law. The name, address and telephone number of the NWSISD designee is on file with the Executive Director. Any questions regarding student transportation or this policy should be addressed to the NWSISD Executive Director or their designee.
