Tommy called for a GSR vote and the GSR's were polled. A unanimous vote to put the monthly minutes onto the website. The Web Master said that he would start putting the minutes on the Web Site. Bill said that the address for It Works How and Why needs to be changed on the Nature Coast Meeting List. Tommy said that Bill needs to bring that up when the LDO gives her report. Christina said that there is a paper going around for the GSR's to add their updated information for their meetings and it would go to the LDO for the next meeting list update. Accepted by Max and seconded by Judy.

Sub-Committee Reports:

Activities Report: No report was given as the Activities Chair person was not present.

Help Line Report: Report was read aloud and attached hereto. Accepted by Max and seconded by Judy.

H&I Report: Report was read aloud and is attached hereto. Christina asked why Nature Coast was going to Springbrook when it is in Brooksville and River Coast goes into Springbrook? Bill said that River Coast is no longer going into Springbrook. Barbara asked why we possibly wouldn't be going into the Oasis any longer in September? Judy said that funding for the Oasis program was being cut and it may not exist come September. Judy also said that it may be a good idea to get a PR presentation together and present it to the County Commissioner's and lobby to keep the Oasis Program going. Bill said that it would be PR in conjunction with H&I to do a presentation, but he wanted to make sure that there was no Traditions issues with bringing a presentation to the County Commissioners. Alvin said that it is not a Traditions issue as that is what PR is for to take information about NA to

the Public. Judy again said that it would be a good idea to take a presentation from PR and H&I to the next County Meeting. Barbara said that it may be a good idea to educate ourselves as to why the funding was being cut for the Oasis before we go to the County Meeting for a presentation. Christina said that she was willing to inquire with her contacts with DCF who provide funding for the Oasis Program. The issue was tabled until next ASC for further information to be requested about funding. Bill asked about the H&I budget and Tommy said that in Policy the budget was \$40.00 a month or \$300.00 per year. Bill said that was not enough and that literature was needed badly for the H&I facilities. Alvin and Barbara said that there was a Motion and vote to raise the budget to \$100.00 a month but no one was sure if the Motion was a policy change or a temporary motion. Christina said that she would check the minutes in the archives for the motion. Rolland said that he would give the H&I Chair the contact information for the Regional H&I Chairperson to request the extra literature that our area needs. Bill also asked if he could get the literature that he orders sooner than the next ASC, proposing that he get it in two weeks. Barbara said that policy states that the LDO gets the order at ASC and H&I gets it at the next ASC, however, Barbara said that she would attempt to get it to him sooner, but she didn't want to commit. Tommy said that most orders are filled the same day anyhow out of the area's stock.

- We will be taking our first meeting into Springbrook Hospital and Rehab today, Sat July 14th
- I am working on another facility, and expanding this one as well with more days added to bring more meetings in. This will be a slow process, as we need to get established at Springbrook before expanding there or taking on new facilities.
- We voted to use World guidelines for our H&I requirements. In effect; 30 days clean to observe, six months to share
- We are only allowed to bring in two people into Springbrook. After a reasonable amount of time, I am going to address this and ask that they allow at least three. This will allow more people to get involved.
- We incorporated the World guidelines for orientation and will amend to cover any guidelines individual facilities require of us, as long as they don't vary from our Traditions
- We discussed the matter of the Oasis suffering budget cuts and the possibility of closing this facility.
- We have an urgent need for literature. When I asked the LDO about filling our order, I was told we would have to wait an entire month before we could get it. We need to discuss this situation.
