Healing

Matthew 11:28-30

Come to me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light. (NKJV)

Loneliness

Psalm 38:9-11

O LORD, all my longing is before you; my sighing is not hidden from you. My heart throbs; my strength fails me, and the light of my eyes - it also has gone from me. My friends and companions stand aloof from my plague, and my nearest kin stand far off.

Psalm 25:16

Turn to me and be gracious to me, for I am lonely and afflicted. (NASB)

Psalm 143: 8-10

Remind me each morning of your constant love, for I put my trust in you. My prayers go up to you; show me the way I should go. I go to you for protection, LORD; rescue me from my enemies. You are my God; teach me to do your will. Be good to me, and guide me on a safe path. (GNT)

Hopeless or Helpless

Psalm 51:17

The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise. (GNT)

Scriptures for Healing and Hope

Hope

Psalm 35:4

Tell everyone who is discouraged, "Be strong and don't be afraid! God is coming to your rescue, coming to punish your enemies." (GNT)

Romans 15:13

Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (NKJV)

Psalm 86:4-7

Make your servant glad, O Lord, because my prayers go up to you. You are good to us and forgiving, full of constant love for all who pray to you. Listen, Lord to my prayer; hear my cries for help. I call to you in times of trouble, because you answer my prayers. (GNT)

Lamentations 3:32

Though he brings grief, he also shows compassion because of the greatness of his unfailing love. (NLT)

Forgiveness

Matthew 6:14-15

If you forgive others the wrongs they have done to you, the Father in heaven will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive the wrongs you have done. (GNT)

Ephesians 5:1-2

Since you are God's dear children, you must try to be like him. Your life must be controlled by love, just as Christ loved us and gave his life for us as sweet smelling offering and sacrifice that pleases God. (GNT)

1 Corinthians 13:5

Love does not keep a record of wrongs. (GNT)

Scriptures for Healing and Hope

2 Corinthians 2:10–11

When you forgive people for what they have done, I forgive them too. For when I forgive - if indeed, I need to forgive anything – I do it in Christ's presence because of you, in order to keep Satan from getting the upper hand over us; for we know what his plans are. (GNT)

For Protection

Psalm 91:1-2

Whoever goes to the Lord for safety, whoever remains under the protection of the Almighty, can say to him, "You are my defender and protector. You are my God; in you I trust." (GNT)

Psalm 91:11

God will put his angels in charge of you to protect you wherever you go. (GNT)

Faith

John 5:24

Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life. (GNT)

Remarriage

Romans 7:1–3

Now, dear brothers and sisters— you who are familiar with the law— don't you know that the law applies only while a person is living? For example, when a woman marries, the law binds her to her husband as long as he is alive. But if he dies, the laws of marriage no longer apply to her. So while her husband is alive, she would be committing adultery if she married another man. But if her husband dies, she is free from that law and does not commit adultery when she remarries. (NLT)

Prosperity

2 Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to give you more than you need, so that you will always have all you need for yourselves and more than enough for every good cause. (GNT)

Fear

2 Timothy 1:7

For the Spirit that God has given us does not make us timid; instead, his Spirit fills us with power, love, and self-control. (GNT)

Psalms 27:1

The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? (NKJV)

Death

Psalms 23:4

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. (NKJV)

Divorce

1 Corinthians 7:15

But if the unbeliever leaves, let it be so. The brother or the sister is not bound in such circumstances. (NIV)

Peace

John 14: 27

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. (NIV)

Psalms 4:8

I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; for You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety. (NKJV)
