**Directions** from Quality Inn & Suites to Lake Wateree State Park- Get on I-77 S towards Columbia get off at exit 48 Hwy 200, make a left at the top of the ramp, go 2.8 miles make a right onto Wateree Rd. Go 1 mile make a slight right to stay on Wateree Rd. Continue straight through the first stop sign. Go 5 miles make a slight left onto River Rd. Go 5 more miles and Lake Wateree Baptist Church will be on the right. Look for USSA signs posted along the route.
