## GENERAL RULES

- The divisions are: Pee Wee (All disciplines, 11 & Under), Novice (All disciplines, 12 & Up), Western Pleasure, Green Horse, English Pleasure, Gaited, Youth Ranch, Adult Ranch, Games Pee Wee (11 & Under), Games Youth (12-17), Games Adult (18 & Up). Competitors do not have to declare a division.
- Age is as of January 1, 2026.
- The decision of the Judge is final.
- Proper dress **is not required** to participate, but respectable clothing is expected.
- When your class is called, **be ready** and prepared to enter the arena as the preceding class is lined up for final inspection.
- **NO** late entries. You **MUST** be registered in class **BEFORE** class is called to the arena.
- Green Horse Division: This division is for *equines* in their first year of showing under saddle. Green equines may not enter canter classes. All disciplines welcomed. The horse may show in Green Horse for 1 show season. Intended for experienced riders who may not enter Novice Division.
- Peewee Division: This is for *riders* 11 years and under of any discipline. Riders who are 11 years and under may choose to show up in their discipline if they are comfortable with that, instead of in the Peewee division, but may not enter in both. May not cross-enter Green Horse division or lope/canter classes.
- Novice Division: This is for *riders* 12 years and up of any discipline, in the first 2 years of showing, who are not comfortable with loping or cantering. May not cross-enter Green Horse division or lope/canter classes or divisions. May not have won high point or series awards.
- Western Pleasure equines may not cross enter into Ranch classes, Ranch equines may not cross enter into Western Pleasure Classes. **Riders may cross enter, on different equines.**
- English & Western classes are for trotting/jogging equine only. Gaited equines will not be placed.
- GAYP = Go As You Please (walk & then any gait above a walk, must use the same gait in both directions).
- Gait codes = **W**-walk, **J**-jog, **T**-trot, **L**-lope, **C**-canter, **B**-back, **SG**-slow gait, **St**-style rack, **GO**- gait-on.
- **You must always maintain control of your equine. If you fail to do so, the judge has the right to remove you from the class for the safety of others.**
- NP means No Points.
- Points are calculated per rider only.
- Points will be earned on a graduated point scale determined by number of class entries, as outlined below:

- **Rain dates will be posted if/when needed for 2026.** All scheduled shows will be awarded on our regular points scale. Shows will be called for weather by 7PM the night before, to the best of our ability, to be posted on the website and social media.
- **Games horses must be across the "starting line" with the gate closed before they may start running.**
- Daily High Point Winners in: Peewee, Western, English, Gaited, Games (Adult, Youth, & PeeWee), Ranch (Adult & Youth), Green Horse, Novice.
- **Year End award for the top 3 places in each division.**
- There will be ONE (1) Versatility Award for 2026. This will be over all of the divisions. Rider must show in minimum of two divisions to be eligible, have completed the sign up form, and paid the fee of \$25 by the 2nd show they attend. Tie breaker rules below apply.
- In the event of a tie at one event, the tie will be broken by the most first placings, then the most second placings, then third, and then fourth.
- In the event of a tie for year end awards, the tie will be broken by whomever attended the most shows in the series. If that number is equal, the tie will be broken by the most first placings, then the most second placings, then third, and then fourth. If there is still a tie, then the highest placing total for the year in classes 13, 14, 15, 16, 33, 34, 35, 36, 41, 42, and 43 of their respective division.
