

## Clifford Township Supervisors Meeting October 14, 2014

Business meeting held on Tuesday October 14, 2014. Chairman Dennis Knowlton called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Motion to approve the minutes by Mr. Knowlton, second by Mr. Searle. All in favor. Treasurer's report reviewed and will be put on file. List of bills reviewed. Mr. Searle made a motion to pay bills except Clifford Auto and Clifford supply, seconded by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor. Mr. Searle made a motion to pay Clifford Auto and Clifford Supply, Mr. Marcho Abstained, seconded by Mr. Knowlton. All in favor. Mr. Marcho abstained due to potential conflict of interest.

Mr. Knowlton Reported that an advertised budget meeting was held on October 13<sup>th</sup> and the results can be viewed starting October 15<sup>th</sup> on the front door.

Old Business: Mr. Searle would like to go ahead with the process of putting a deer crossing sign on Airport Road.

Mr. Searle made a motion to resend the motion made at the previous meeting to have Barhite work on Elk View Road because of bidding rules. Mr. Knowlton seconded. All in favor.

Kurt Booths thanked the supervisors for the work that was done on Elk View Drive and asked about ditch work. Mr. Marcho said the work will be done soon and Mr. Searle asked Kurt to please let his neighbors know that the ditch work has to be done to prolong the life of the roads.

Mr. Marcho reported that DEP needed to extend review on the Act 537 plan. Decision should be made by the end of December.

Mr. Marcho reported that the Montrose Area Adult School seemed to be a success.

New Business: Mr. Marcho asked Christy Bennett, Sally Fischbeck and Sally Roberts to work together on building a new web site for the township.

Mr. Searle made a motion to change Wrights Rd. to Elkdale Rd. Mr. Knowlton seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Searle made a motion to except the terms of the Grant for the nature trails. Mr. Knowlton seconded. All in favor.

Tax Collector: Mr. Phillips collected \$1857.90 in real estate and \$182.98 in fire protection. \$18351.91 in real estate tax and \$1529.80 in fire protection is still outstanding.

Historical Society: Sandy Wilmot obtained a grant to put a new roof on the cider mill. October 19<sup>th</sup> will be the last weekend that the Old School House and the Baptist Church will be open until next spring.
